***** Do not tighten screws & bolts until the entire unit is completely assembled.**

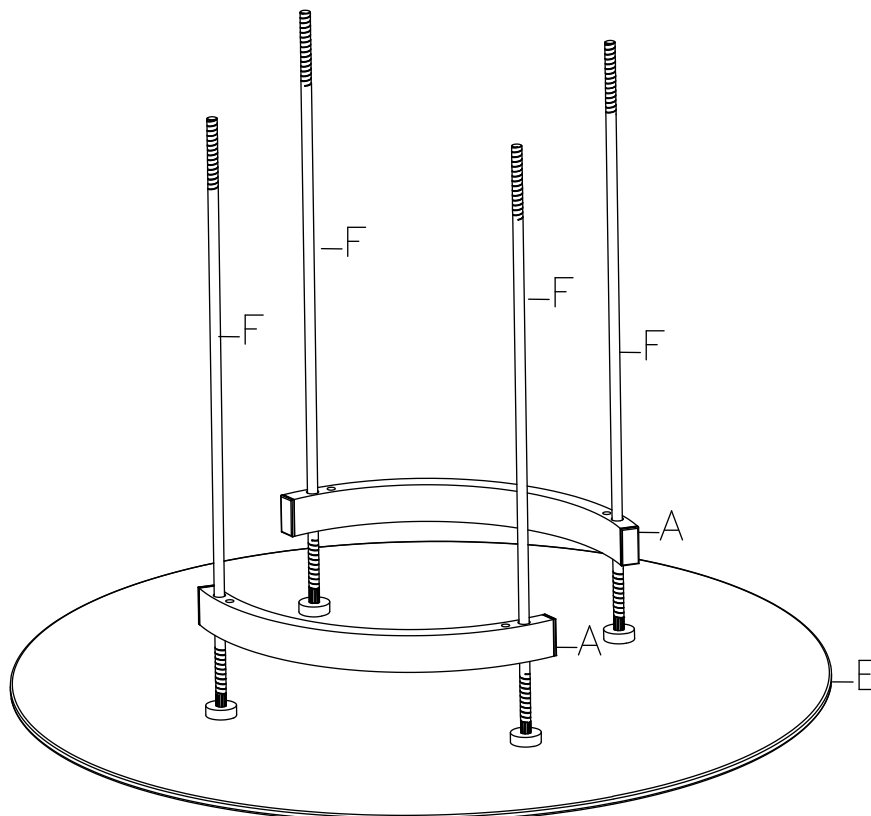

Screw long bolts (F) into corresponding holes on the glass top (E) as shown and tighten it.



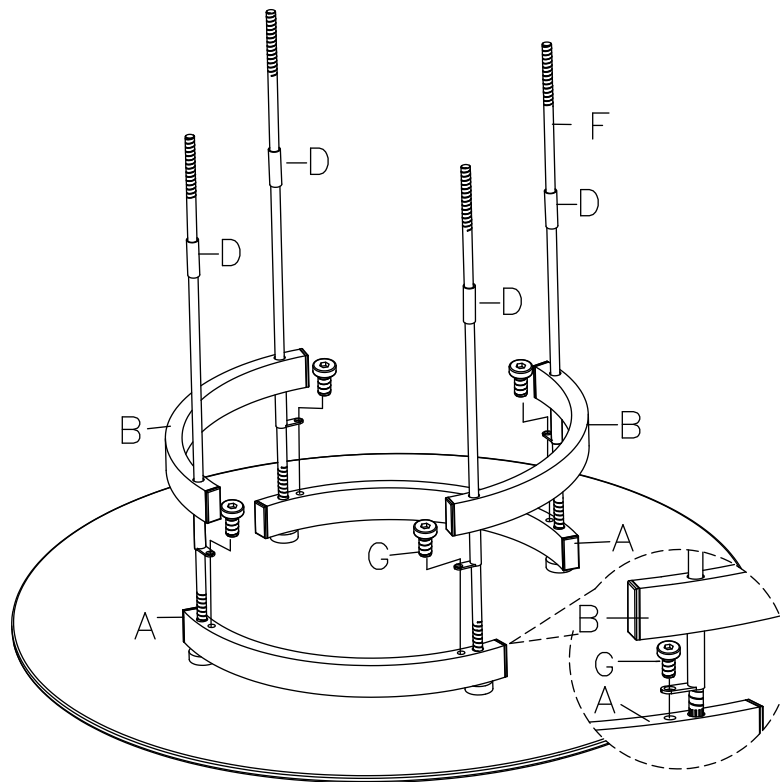

Insert attached long bolts (F) through the corresponding holes on stretchers (A) as shown below.

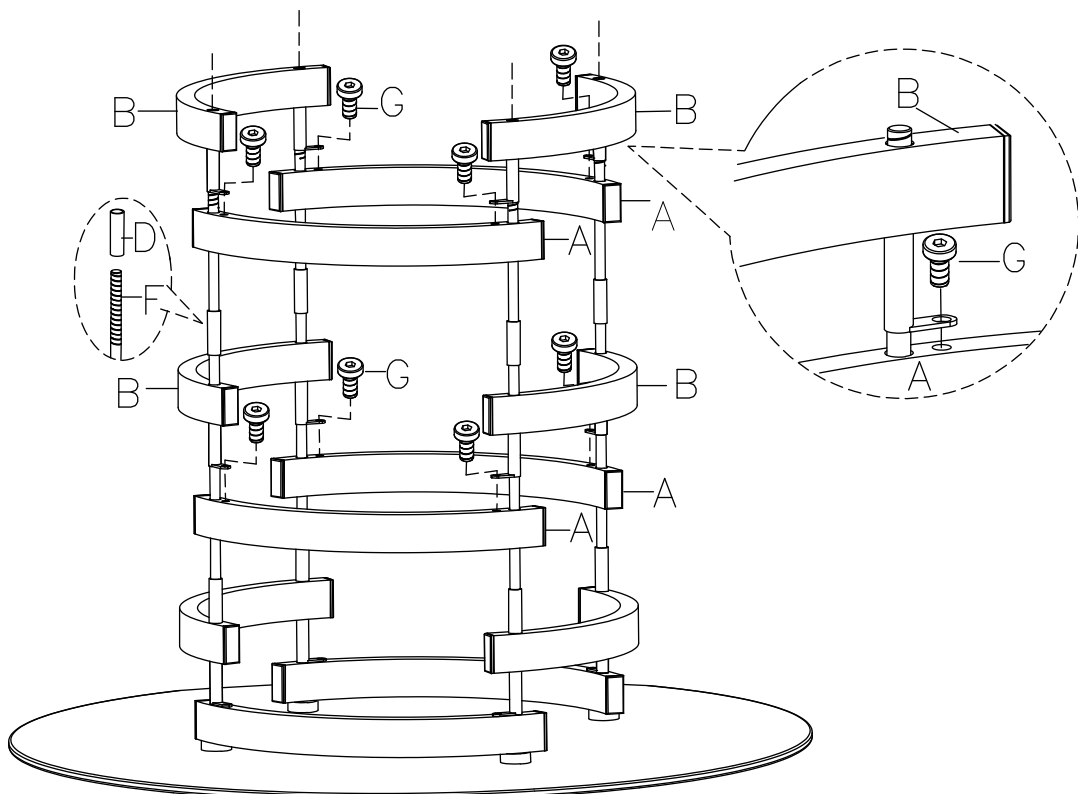

Insert attached long bolts (F) through the corresponding holes on stretchers (B) and fix stretchers (B) to stretchers (A) using bolts (G). Then, follow with connector tubes (D) as shown. .

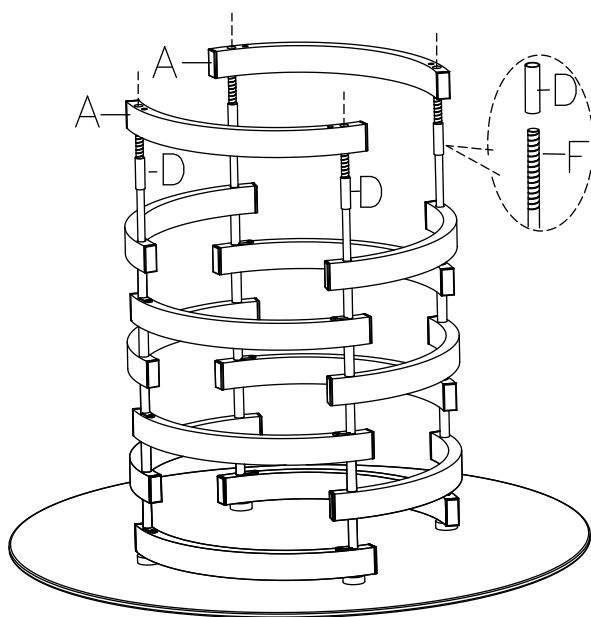

Following Step 3 to use stretchers (A), stretchers (B) and connector tubes (D) to build up the frame step by step. Then, tighten bolts (G) firmly.



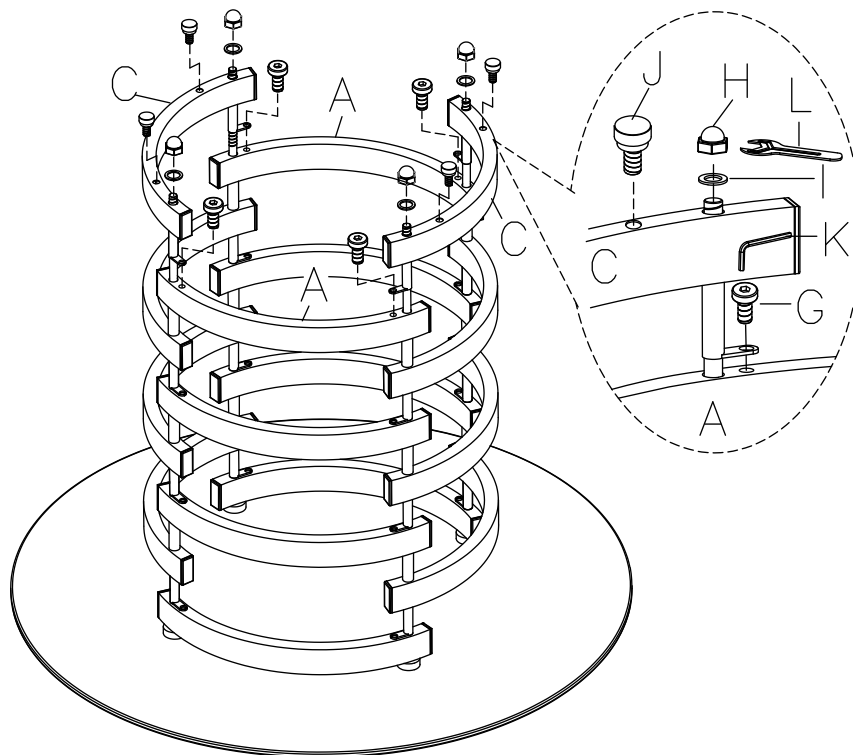

Attach connector tubes (D) and stretchers (A) to long bolts (F) again.

Attach stretchers (C) to stretchers (A) using bolts (G) as shown.

Fix the frame firmly using flat washers (I) and nuts (H) with open wrench (L). Then, attach levelers (J) to the bottom of stretchers (C) as shown. Carefully, turn the assembled unit upright. The chop dining table is now completed.












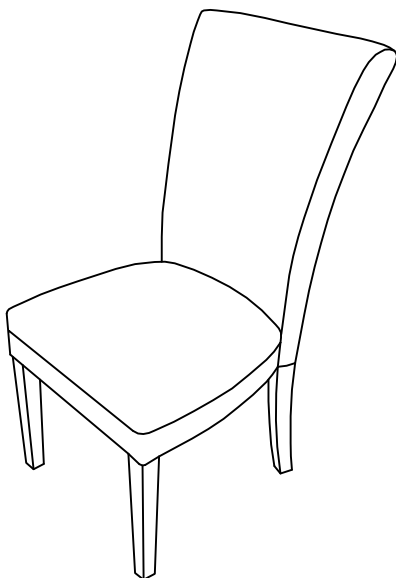
Cleaning & Care

Treat surface with care. Surface is resistant to scratches but is not scratch resistant. Clean surfaces with a dry or damp soft cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners. Hardware may loosen over time. Periodically check that all connections are tight.

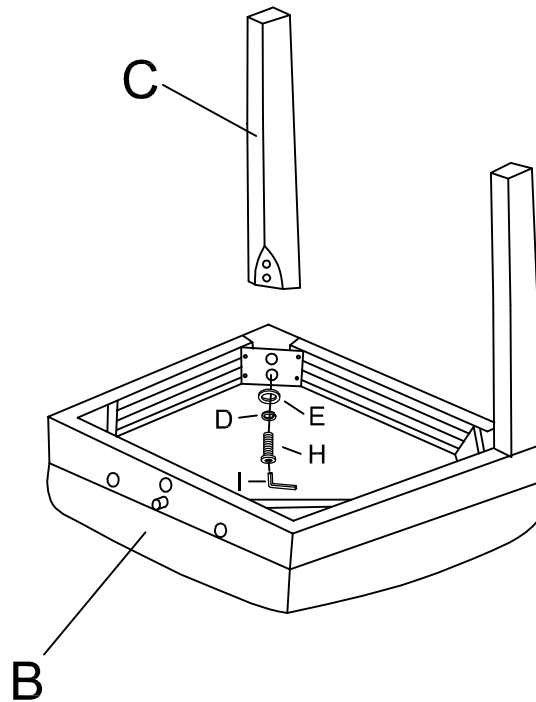

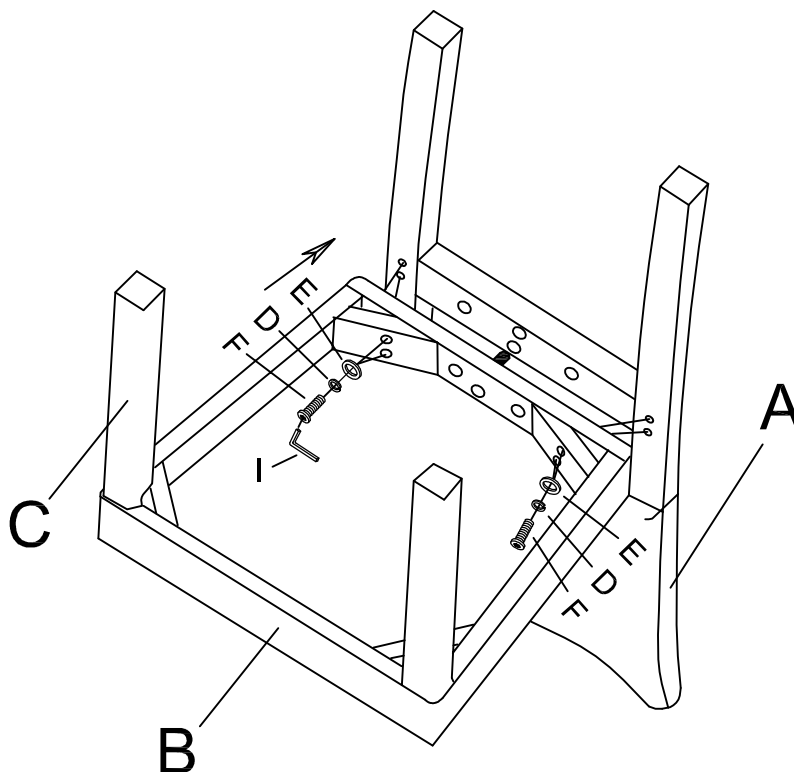

Put the seat (B) on a smooth flat surface, attached one front leg (C) to the seat (B) use bolt (H), lock washer (D) and flat washer (E) on both of hole of seat. Turn the allen wrench (I) in bolt (H). But not too tight.

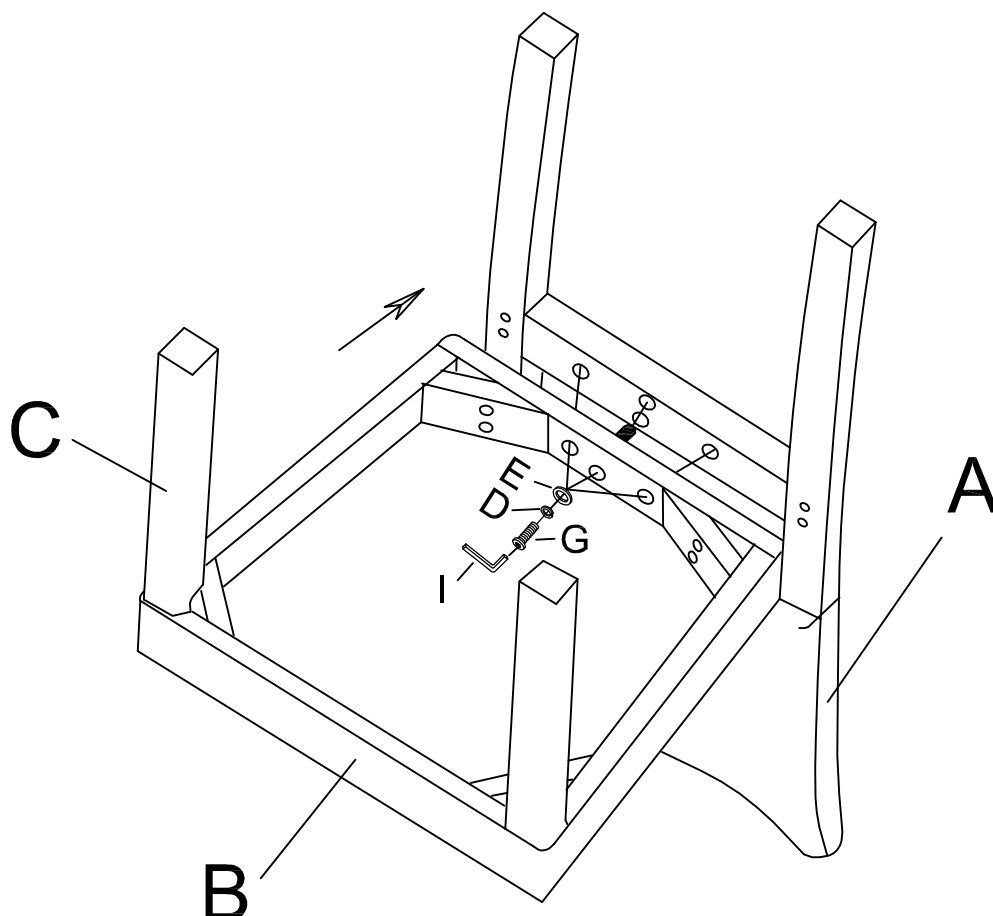

Put chair back (A) on a smooth flat surface, attached the seat (B) the chair back (A) use the bolt (F), lock washer (D), flat washer (E) in both of hole of seat (B) and chair back (A), turn the allen wrench (I) in bolt (F). But not too tight.

Use the bolt (G), lock washer (D), flat washer (E) in both of hole of seat (B) and chair back (A), turn the allen wrench (I) to tighten the bolt (G).



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
