



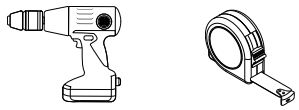

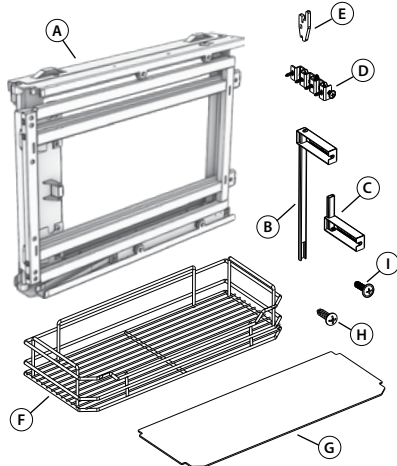
### TOOLS NECESSARY:

NOTE: If screw gun has a clutch, set to lowest setting so as not to over tighten and/or strip screws.

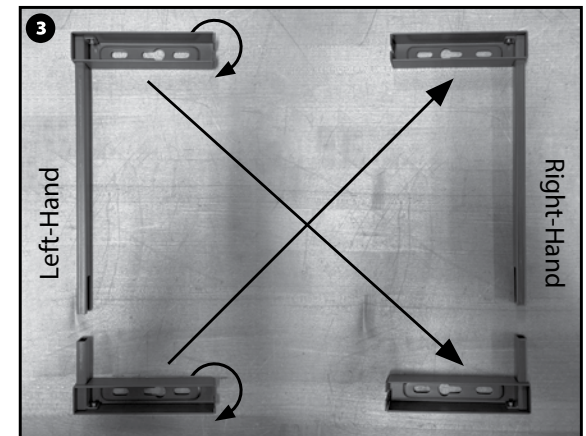
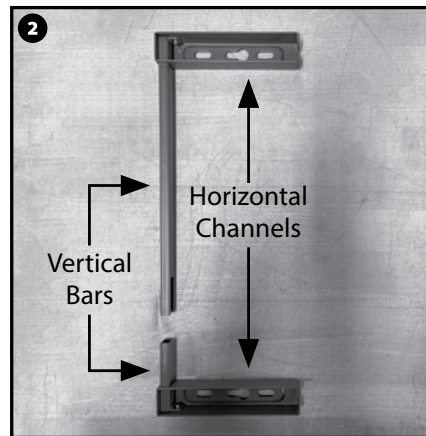
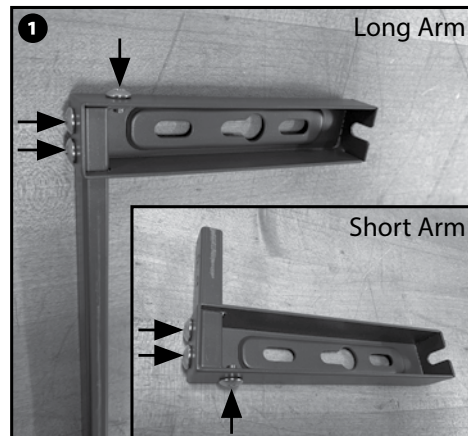
### PARTS IDENTIFICATION:

I	#8 x 5/8" Pan Head Phillips Wood Screw	8X

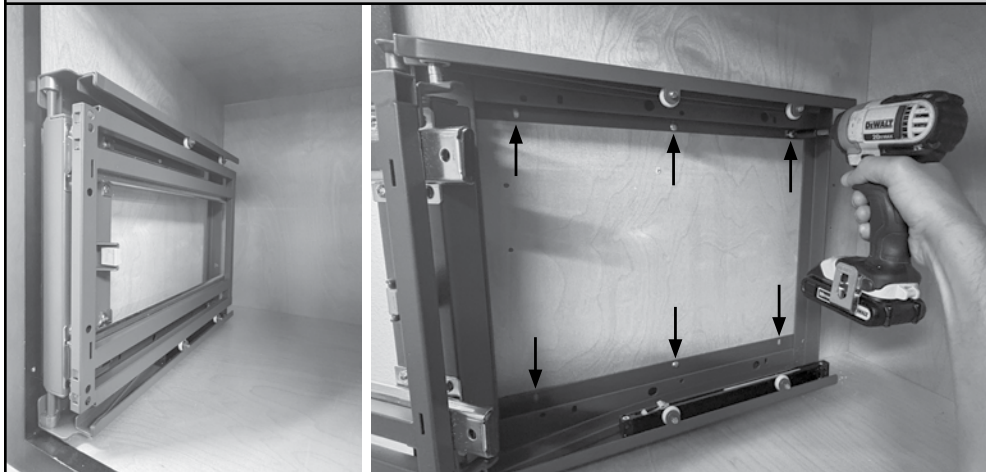
## Right-Hand Installation (Optional)

This unit comes assembled for left-hand installation. For right-hand installation, the door bracket arms need to be converted for the correct orientation before installing in the cabinet.



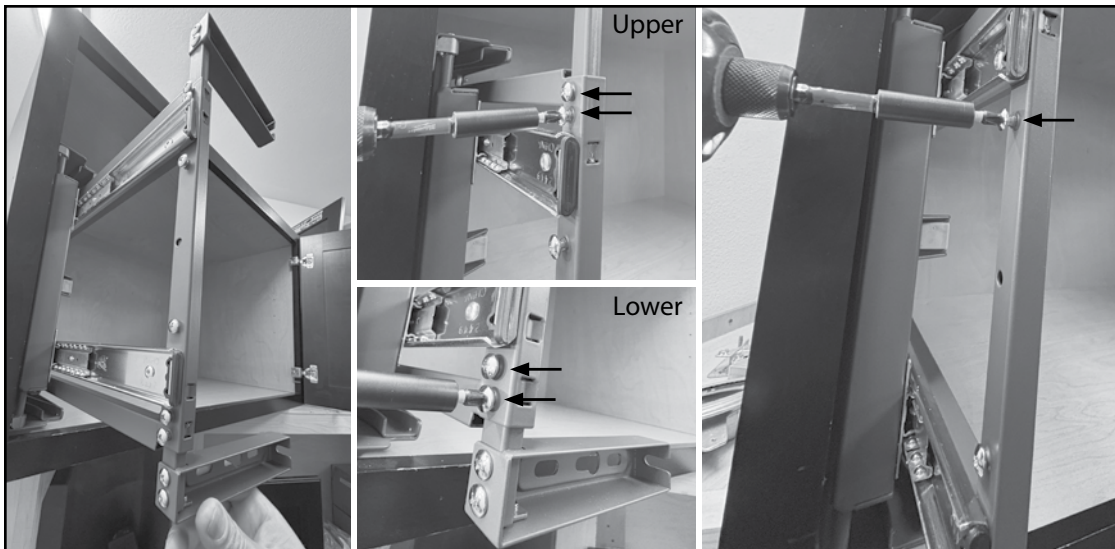
Remove (6) screws as shown above (Figure 1). Then, separate the horizontal channels from the vertical bars (Figure 2). Take the horizontal bar from the short arm, rotate it 180° so that the holes for the two screws are on the right side, and then slide it onto the vertical bar from the long arm. Take the horizontal channel from the long arm, rotate it 180° so that the holes for the two screws are on the right side, and then slide it onto the vertical bar from the short arm (Figure 3). Using the 6 screws from the first step, reassemble the door bracket arms in the new right-hand orientation.

## Cabinet Installation



**1**

Place unit against inside cabinet wall as shown with the edge against rear of face frame (for frameless cabinets, set back 3/4"). Cycle the unit to gain access to the mounting holes, and secure to the cabinet side with (6) #8 x 1/2" screws.



**2**

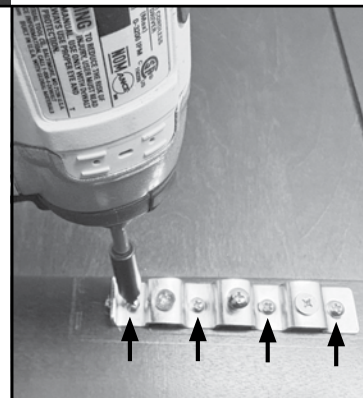
With unit extended, insert lower door arm into bottom of pullout and upper door arm into top as shown. Adjust the arms so they are within 1/8" of cabinet opening and tighten the machine screws at the locations shown to keep the arms in place.

If installing the unit in a cabinet with a 15" door opening height, tighten the screw located just below the top slide to secure the door arms in place.



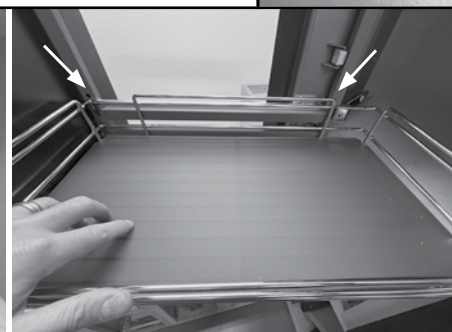
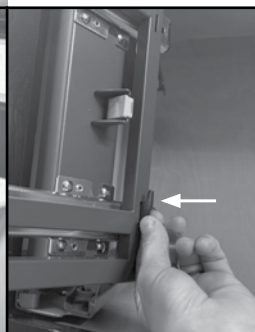

Close the unit and temporarily hold the door in its approximate location. With the opposite door open, reach into the cabinet and lightly trace around door bracket arms (upper and lower) to aid in bracket installation.



**4**

Remove the door and center the attachment brackets between the marks made in step 3 and secure with (4) #8 x 5/8" screws per bracket.



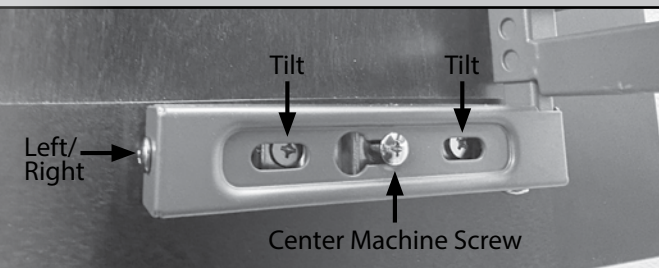
**6**

Insert (2) basket hooks into the lower slots of the pullout as shown. Set basket onto the hooks and place the liner into the basket.

**5**

Secure the door to the unit by sliding the attachment bracket center screw into the keyhole of the door bracket arms and tighten the center screw.

## Door Adjustment



**Left/Right:** Loosen center machine screw and adjust machine screw on side of horizontal door arm. Retighten center screw.

**Up/Down:** Loosen screws securing vertical door arms from Step 2. Adjust and retighten.

**Tilt:** Loosen center machine screw and turn 2 outside screws in/out for desired tilt. Retighten center screw.
