




***Do not tighten screws & bolts until the entire unit is completely assembled.

Attach Metal Leg (G) to the Lower Frame (F) by using Bolt (H) and Allen Wrench (O) as shown.




Attach Side Frame (D) to the Lower Frame (F) by using Bolt (I) and Allen Wrench (O) as shown.





Attach Drawer (C) to the metal base by using Bolt (I) and Allen Wrench (O) as shown.





Attach Center Frame (E) to the Drawer (C) by using Bolt (J) and Allen Wrench (O) as shown.





Attach Lower Panel (B) to the Side Frame (D) and Center Frame (E) by using Bolt (H), Bolt (I) and Allen Wrench (O) as shown.


Attach Top Panel (A) to the Side Frame (D) and Center Frame (E) by using Bolt (H), Bolt (I) and Allen Wrench (O) as shown.





*NOTE: WE RECOMMEND THAT YOU ATTACH THE PRODUCT TO YOUR WALL AS A SAFETY PRECAUTION.

- (1) Attach Mounting Plate (M) to the Bottom of the Top Panel (A) with Bolt (H), making sure the Mounting Plate (M) extend DOWNWARD as shown.
- (2) Drill 2 holes in your wall approximately 2" BELOW the corresponding positions of Mounting Plate (M) and insert Wall Anchor (L) as shown.
- *NOTE: You may need to tap LIGHTLY with a rubber mallet.
- (3) Attach Mounting Plate (M) to Wall Anchor (L) with Wood Screw (K) using a Philips Head Screwdriver (not provided). Make sure the Mounting Plate (M) extend UPWARD.
- (4) Now connect the corresponding Mounting Plate (M) with Connection Strap (N) and tighten as desired before locking in place.



Cleaning & Care

Treat surface with care. Surface is resistant to scratches but is not scratch resistant. Clean surfaces with a dry or damp soft cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners. Hardware may loosen over time. Periodically check that all connections are tight.
