WINERY

Eighth-generation family-owned winery by the Coulon family who own more than 80 acres of Châteauneuf-du-Pape vineyards that are 45 years old on average and cultivated organically and biodynamically Today, biodynamic farming is the obvious choice. Man works in harmony with nature, driven by a profound respect for Terroirs and for Life. Le Petit Renard was born out of a desire to share our passion and make it accessible through wines that are pure and sincere, wines that we love.

WINE

Le Petit Renard is the fruit of virtuous agriculture. A subtle blend of terroirs, Rhône grapes, and passionate people. This wine embodies a simple and noble provencal art of living that the Coulon family cultivates and carefully protects.

VINEYARDS

The grapes are harvested within a radius of 30 km around the estate and come exclusively from the magnificent terroirs and appellations of the southern Rhône Valley: AOC Côtesdu-Rhône, AOC Côtes-du-Rhône villages, AOC Ventoux. We have chosen to classify them as Vin de France, which gives us incomparable freedom to blend terroirs and grape varieties in order to create complex and singular wines, reflections of a region and an assumed audacity. We select grapes from fellow winegrowers attached to the virtues of biodynamics and the preservation of the environment of our region.

WINEMAKING

It all starts with a careful selection of the grapes. In the cellar, only the first juices, elegant and aromatic, are kept. Then comes the vinification: respect of the astral calendar,

slow fermentation at controlled temperature, and a rest in bottle. At each of these stages, the Coulon Family draws the balance of the wine until it affixes its signature: a daring triptych between fragrance, delicacy and minerality.

VINTAGE NOTES

2023 vintage is most likely to be an amazing vintage. We have never seen such an original season, starting with a drought in the winter and early spring and very dry conditions, then we were hit twice by the hale in some cdp vineyards. The month of June turned out to be very wet and humid and a bit challenging in term of viticulture. The summer has been dry and warm but without extreme temperature except at the end of august. Harvest, then started quite early but a couple rains helped the ripening to slow down and we were able to pick grapes for six weeks at a slow pace and with exceptional conditions for each Vineyard. Wines so far are very aromatic, balanced, elegant and with a medium bodied tannins structure. We are very confident about it and I must say pride of the results in a year full of various challenges.

TASTING NOTES

This wine is pure and energetic, perfectly achieving our goal of lightness and freshness. It remains firmly rooted in the region's characteristic with vibrant flavors such as crisp fruit, a floral touch and a pleasantly velvety texture on the palate. This exquisite blend not only reflects the unique qualities of the region but also exemplifies our dedication to crafting wines that are both elegant and invigorating.
