#### Glossary of Terms:

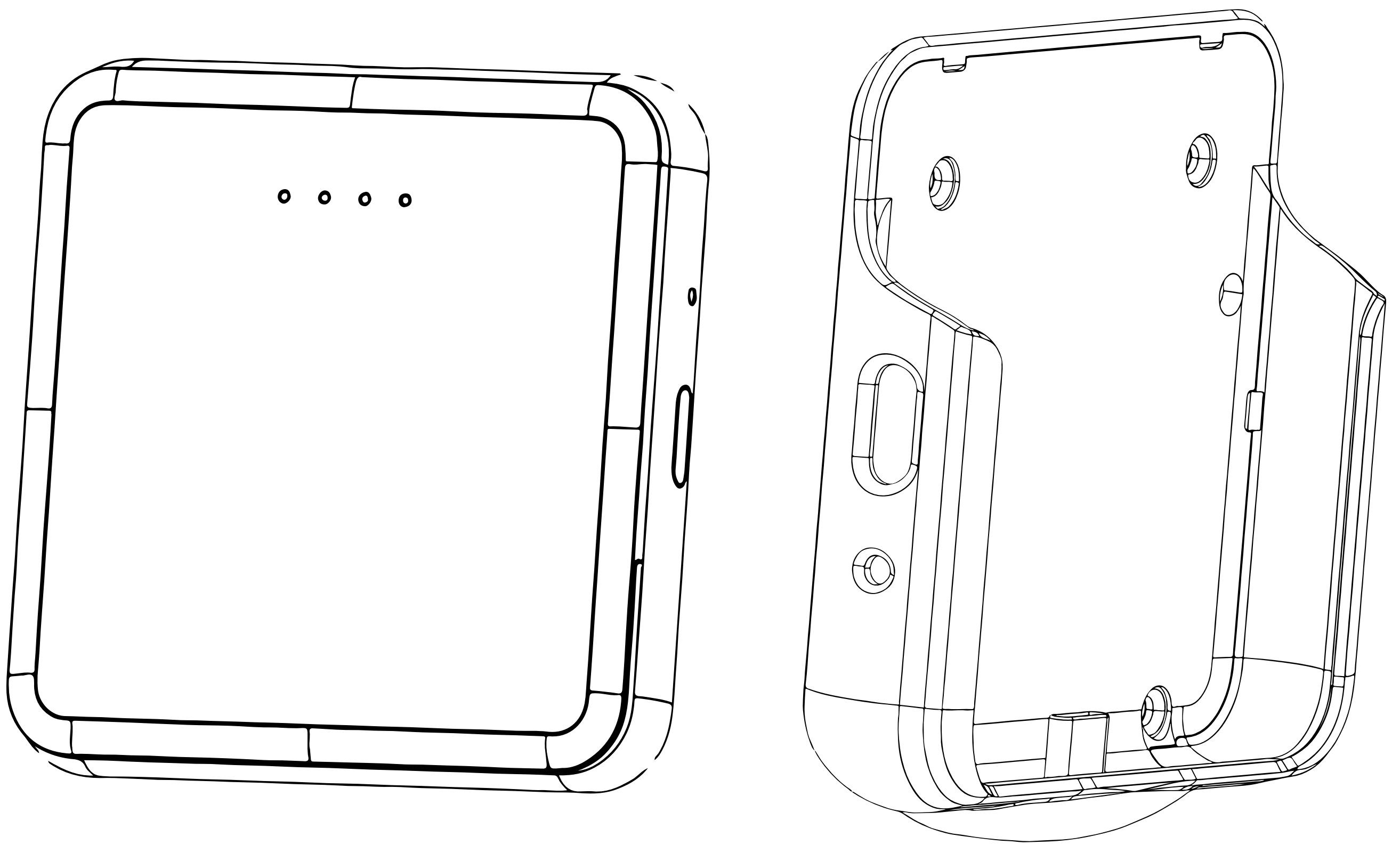
- **CONNECT Phone Case** - The Finished mobile case for iPhone 13-14, or iPhone 15, providing a mounting location for a Payment Processor Case.
- **Payment Processor Case** - The removable housing providing charging and mounting for a Aurus Vayu payment processor.

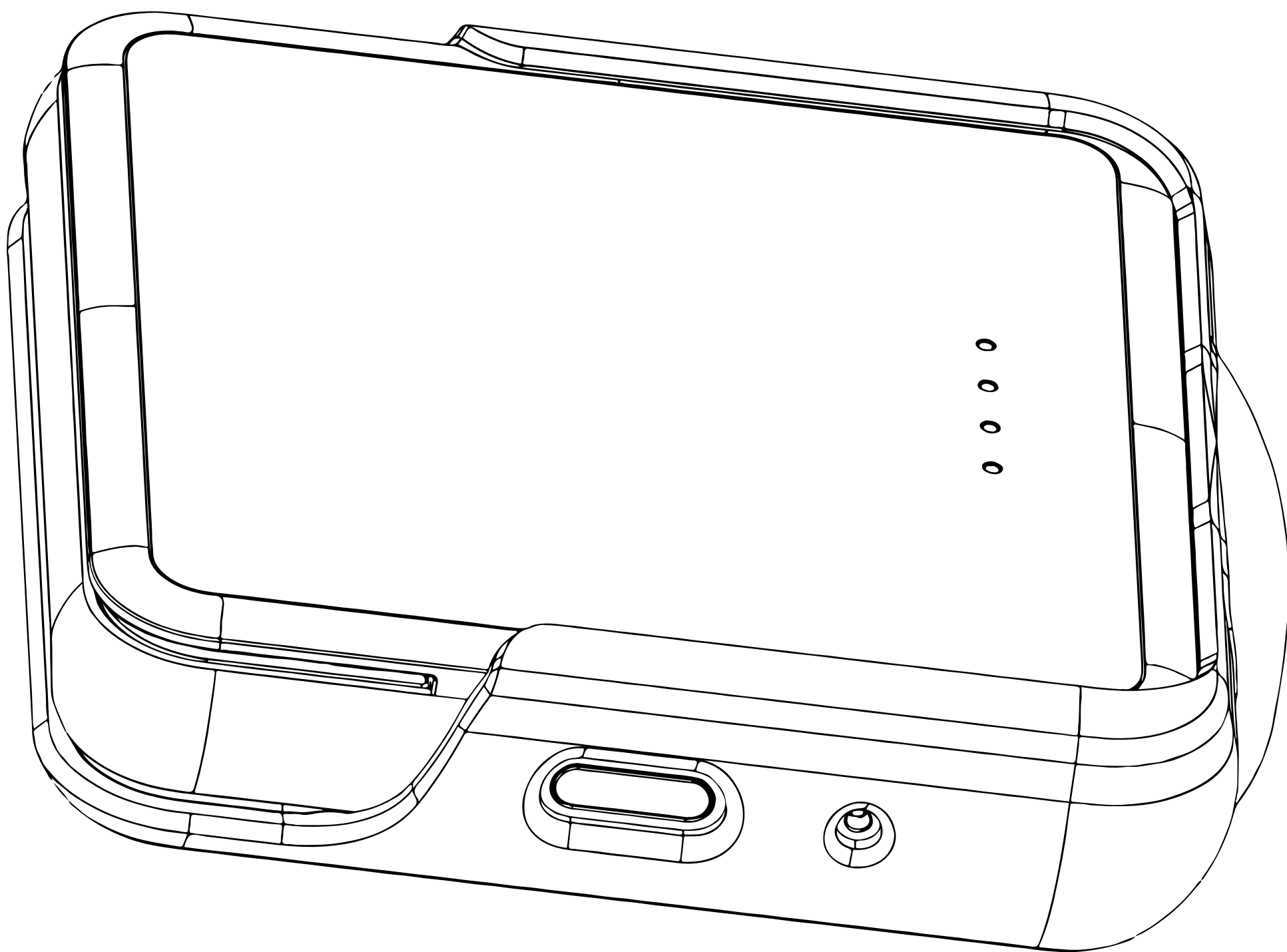
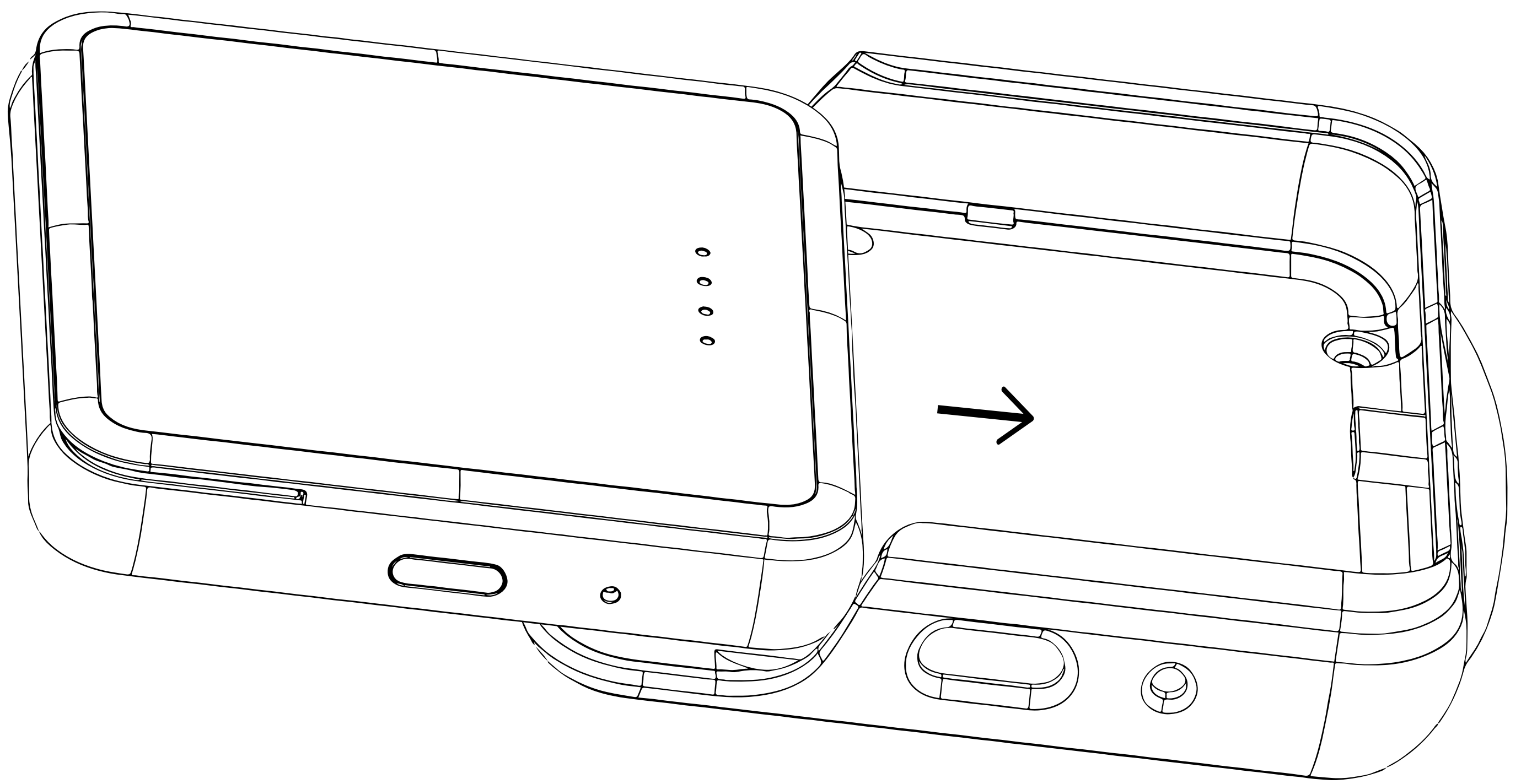
- 1. Remove the Vayu payment processor and the PayCase from their packaging.**

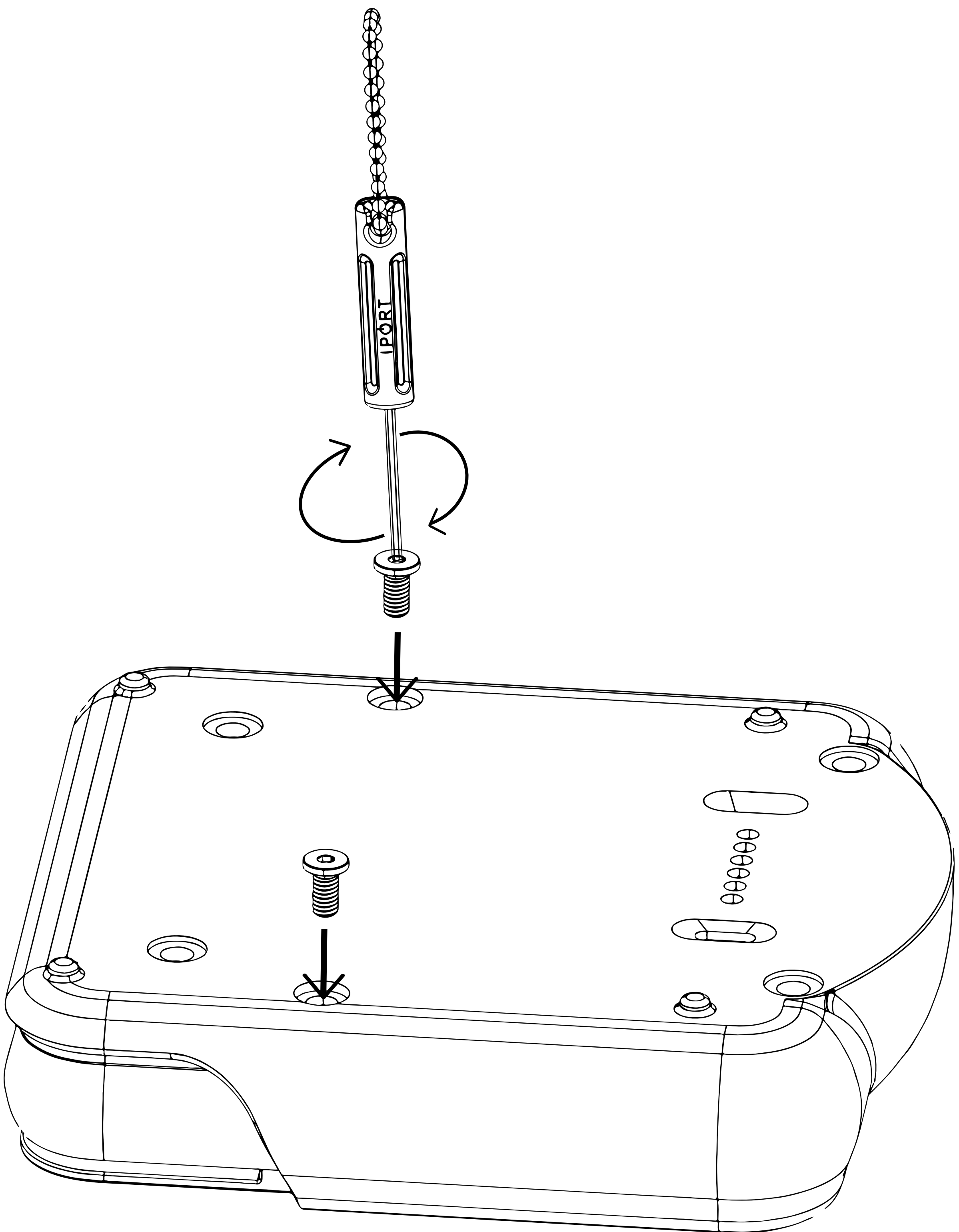
**2. Slide the Vayu into the USB-C connection at the top of the PayCase first, ensuring it is securely seated into the port. Make sure to press firmly until the Vayu device clicks into place.**

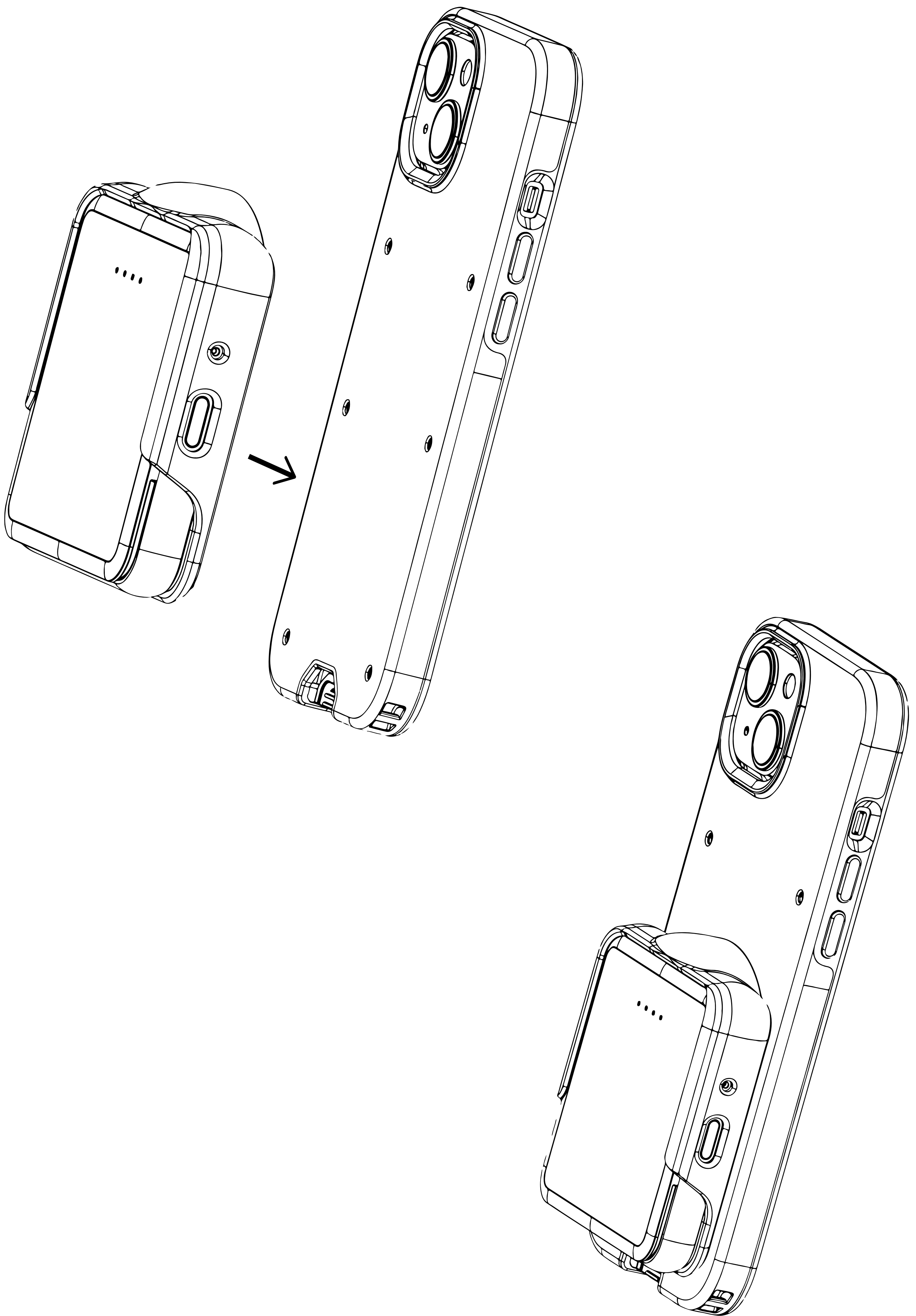
**3. Turn the Vayu PayCase over and use the provided IPORT Security tool to install the two provided retention screws.**

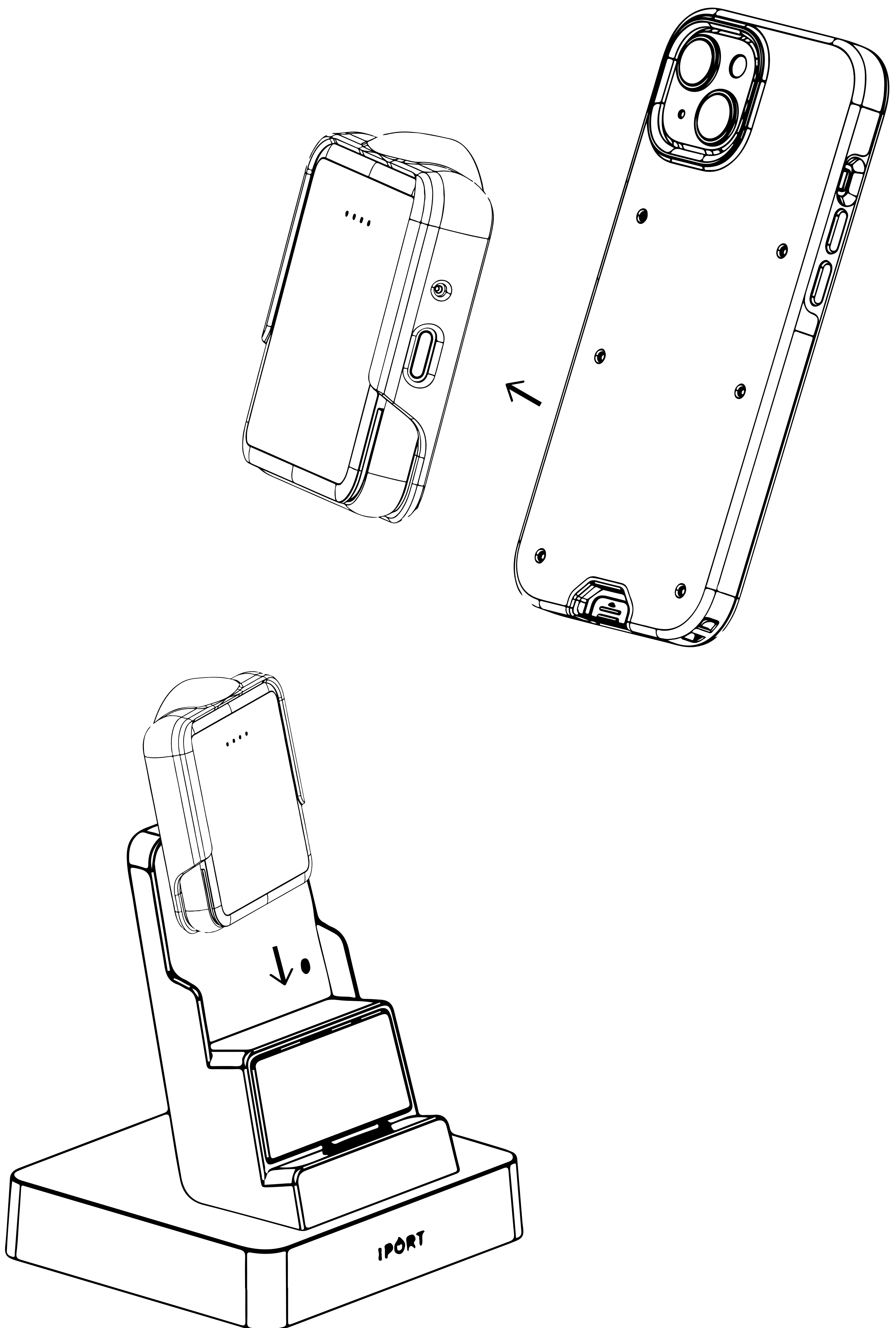
**4. Once the Vayu is installed in the CONNECT Phone PayCase place the Vayu Case onto the back of an iPhone installed in a CONNECT Phone Case.**

**5. To charge the Vayu PayCase, remove the PayCase from the phone and place the Vayu Face out from the dock in the top charging location.**

**6. Once the PayCase has been removed and is charging on the Dock, place the CONNECT Phone Case face out and place it onto the Dock.**
