THE PROBLEM

Stanley Black & Decker's facility in Sedalia, Missouri is responsible for manufacturing metal cabinets from the DeWalt, Craftsman, and Stanley brands. Workers at this facility are required to wear safety eyewear as part of their complete protective kit.

Safety eyewear plays a pivotal role in protecting workers from flying debris, sparks, dust, metal shavings, and other hazards that could cause temporary blindness or permanent injuries

Unfortunately, there was a problem with the safety eyewear they were using: it just wasn't comfortable. These glasses are worn for extended periods of time, often throughout the entire shift.

The discomfort led workers to remove their eyewear, posing a considerable safety risk and violating OSHA regulations.
