


METAL BASE ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

WARNING: Keep the Collector Cabinet stable on the floor. Keep children away and do not allow the Collector Cabinet to tip over.



CAUTION: We recommend two (2) people for the following assembly procedure. Perform this procedure <u>prior</u> to installing shelves. Prior to assembly, move the Collector Cabinet near its final location in your home.

Base Hardware Parts List:

- 1 Front Leg Assembly
- 1 Back Leg Assembly
- 2 End Assembly
- 14 1/2" Long Screws
- 4 1" Long Screws
- 18 Washers
- 1 Allen Wrench

- 1. Locate and unpack the Base Hardware Parts.
- 2. Assemble the End Assemblies to the Front and Back Leg Assemblies using 1/2" Long Screws and Washers as shown in Figure 1 at each of the four corners.
- 3. Attach the 1" Long Screws and Washers at four (4) locations shown in Figure 1.
- 4. Lock the Collector Cabinet door. With two (2) adults, choose a location for the Collector Cabinet and gently lay it on its back on a flat and clean surface.
- 5. Position the Base onto the bottom of the Collector Cabinet with the Back Leg Assembly on the floor and the Front Leg Assembly facing up. If the Base does not lay flat on the floor, the Base front and back are in the wrong position. Re-position the Base to switch the location of the front and back.
- 6. Locate the Threaded Inserts on the bottom of the Collector Cabinet and align with the holes on the Base. Attach the Base with 1/2" Long Screws and Washers as shown in Figure 2 at six (6) locations.
- 7. Carefully set the Collector Cabinet upright and ensure stability on the floor. Immediately refer to your Cabinet Instructions for proper leveling procedures and safety strap assembly.
