

STROLLER is suitable for a child, who can sit up unassisted, up to 50 lb (22.7 kg) and 45 in. (114.3 cm), and WHEN SEATED, the midpoint of the child's head is at or below the top of the stroller seat.

Storage maximum weight is 11 lb (5 kg).

Cup holder maximum weight is 1 lb (0.5 kg).

Adult assembly required.

WARNING

- Failure to follow these instructions could result in the death or serious injury of your child.
- **NEVER LEAVE CHILD UNATTENDED. ALWAYS** keep child in view when in stroller.
- **AVOID SERIOUS INJURY** from falling or sliding out. **ALWAYS** use seat belt. Check frequently to make sure it is secure.
- **ALWAYS** keep fingers away from moving parts, when folding, unfolding, or adjusting stroller to prevent finger entrapment.
- **ALWAYS** make sure stroller is **FULLY OPEN AND LOCKED** before using.
- **ALWAYS** use the brakes when stroller is stopped.
- **ALWAYS** remove protective material and poly bags and dispose before assembly.
- **NEVER** put hot liquids in the cup holder.
- **NEVER** use stroller on stairs or escalators.
- **NEVER** rollerblade with stroller.

- **NEVER** allow children to play with or hang onto the stroller.

- **NEVER** allow children to climb into the stroller unassisted. Stroller may tip over and injure child.

- **NEVER** place or hang parcels, bags, or accessories on the product, handle, or canopy. The stroller may become unstable, or tip over.

- **NEVER** place more than 1 lb (0.5 kg) in cup holder.

- This product may become unstable if package carrying accessories, other than recommended by the manufacturer, are added.

- This product will become unstable if the manufacturer's recommended loads are exceeded.

- **ONLY** use this stroller with **ONE** child at a time.

- **STROLLER** is for use with children who can sit up unassisted, and is **NOT** recommended for newborns.



Unfolding the Stroller




Locate the frame fold release buttons on the handlebar. Squeeze in the small button first and then squeeze in the larger button. While squeezing both buttons, unfold the stroller by pulling it up until it clicks into place.


⚠️ WARNING

ALWAYS keep fingers away from moving parts, when folding, unfolding, or adjusting stroller to prevent finger entrapment.


Installing the Bumper Bar



To install the bumper bar:
Push both ends of the bumper bar into their respective slots on the stroller until they click into place. Pull on each side to confirm it is secure.




To open the bumper bar: Press the release button on one side of the bumper bar. While pressing the button, pull one side of the bumper bar out and away from the stroller. The bar will be able to move and rotate while open.



To remove the bumper bar:
Press both release buttons where the ends of the bumper bar meet the stroller frame. While pressing the buttons, pull the bar out and away from the stroller.

Installing the Cup Holder



To install the cup holder: Align the cup holder with the post on the side of the frame. Slide the cup holder down onto the post until it clicks into place. There are posts on both sides of the stroller frame; the cup holder can be installed on either one. Pull gently on the side to confirm the cup holder is attached securely.


To remove the cup holder: Push up on the bottom of the cup holder until it slides off the post.



Using the Parking Brake

ALWAYS use the parking brake when standing still, even if only for a few moments!




To lock the brake: Push down on the back of the pedal in between the rear wheels.





To unlock the brake: Lift the pedal between the rear wheels up, or push the front of the pedal down.

Using the Canopy





Extend the canopy by pulling it forward.

To further extend the canopy, unzip the canopy to reveal a mesh panel. Pull the canopy forward until it is fully extended.





Adjusting the Stroller Seat



Use the recline strap on the back of the stroller to adjust the stroller seat positions.


To recline the seat: Press the button on the recline strap. While holding the button, pull the strap back until the seat drops downward.





To bring the seat upright: Press the button on the recline strap. While holding the button, pull the strap and slide the button forward until the seat is fully upright.

The seat can also be brought upright by pulling upward on the recline strap with one hand.


Adjusting the Leg Rest



Squeeze the button beneath the leg rest. While squeezing the button, pull the leg rest forward or push it back to one of three positions.




Press the button to unbuckle the harness. Unfasten the snaps on both harness covers to remove them for easier access to the shoulder straps.




To adjust the length of the shoulder straps:
Hold the slide ring in one hand and the buckle clip in the other. Slide the ring up to shorten the strap or down to lengthen it.

To adjust the length of the waist straps: Pull the waist strap through the slide ring to shorten or lengthen it.


Securing Your Child in the Stroller




Unfasten the harness by pressing the center button on the buckle.




Place your child in the stroller seat with the buckle strap between their legs.



Fit the waist strap buckle clip on the child's right into the harness strap buckle clip on the same side. It will click into place. Hold them together and insert them into the buckle.



Repeat for the other side.





To remove your child from the stroller, press the button to unbuckle the harness.



Folding the Stroller




Squeeze in the small frame fold release button and then squeeze the larger button. While squeezing both buttons, push the top of the stroller forward and down until the stroller starts to fold. Lower the stroller frame until it folds into place.

Once the stroller is completely folded, you may store it in the included travel bag (see next page).



For the most compact fold, fasten the toggle on the back of the seat, remove the cup holder, and make sure the leg rest is folded all the way down. To use the leg rest, see page 16. To remove the cup holder, see page 11.



The stroller can be stored inside the included travel bag when folded completely (see previous page). The cup holder and car seat adapters **MUST** be removed before storing the stroller inside the travel bag. To remove the cup holder, see page 11. To remove the car seat adapters, see page 27. Place the bag over the top of the folded stroller and then lay the stroller down. Pull the bag around the bottom of the stroller and then zip.

When inserting the stroller into the travel bag, the stroller's handelbars should be against the side of the bag with the backpack straps. This allows for the most comfortable carrying position.

- **ALWAYS** use the restraint system in the car seat.






This stroller is compatible with all Maxi-Cosi infant car seats.

The car seat **MUST** be installed parent-facing (also known as rear-facing).

Remove the bumper bar before installing the car seat (see page 10).

Locate the car seat adapter attachment slots on the stroller frame. Slide the adapters down into the attachment slots until they click into place.




Lower the car seat onto the car seat adapters until it clicks into place. Once installed, pull up on the car seat either at the carry handle or at the handle hubs to check if it is securely attached.




Removing the Car Seat from the Stroller Frame



To remove the car seat: Press and hold the release button on the car seat and lift the car seat off the stroller. Consult your car seat's instruction manual for detailed instructions.



To remove the car seat adapters from the stroller: Press and hold the release button and slide the adapter up and out from the stroller frame. Repeat with the other adapter.

⚠ CAUTION

Before putting the folded stroller into a vehicle, the adapters **MUST** be removed.




Spot clean the stroller with soap and warm water.

To clean the harness covers, seat pad, and travel bag: Machine wash each item separately with cold water on a gentle cycle. Make sure the harness covers are closed so that the fastening snaps are not exposed. Do not use bleach. Tumble dry alone for 10–12 minutes on low heat. Remove them immediately after.


To remove the seat pad: Unbuckle the harness system and remove the harness covers. Pull the harness straps through the seat pad and pull the seat pad out of the stroller.

Removing the Front Wheels




Press the front wheel release button on the stroller frame. While pressing the button down, pull the wheel out of the stroller frame. Repeat for the other wheel.

Installing the Front Wheels




Insert each wheel into the stroller frame until they click into place. Pull on each wheel to make sure they are secured.

Removing the Rear Wheels




Press the rear wheel release button on the back of the stroller frame. While pressing the button down, pull the wheel out of the frame. Repeat for the other wheel.



Insert each wheel into the frame until they click into place. Pull on each wheel to make sure they are secured.
