



### Color Guide

**1 - Blue Wash** (Blue + Water)

**2 - Purple then Blue Horizontal strokes** (Wet on Dry)

**3 - Blue & Teal Horizontal Strokes** (Wet on Dry)

**4 - Green & Teal Vertical Strokes** (Wet on Dry)

**5 - Teal & Blue Vertical Strokes** (Wet on Dry)

**6 - Purple & Blue Vertical Strokes** (Wet on Dry)

**7 - White & Rose** (Wet on Wet)

**8 - Yellow**

**9 - Rose**

**Tip:** Add horizontal blue strokes to make the painting more fluid & give more of a watery effect.

**Fun Facts:** • This depiction of “Water Lilies” is actually only one from a series of about 250 paintings of his garden at his home in Giverny, France.

- Monet’s “Water Lilies” paintings are displayed at museums all over the world, including the Cleveland Museum of Art, Musée d’Orsay in Paris, and the National Museum of Wales.
- Other Impressionist painters include: Mary Cassatt, Paul Cézanne, Edgar Degas, and Pierre-Auguste Renoir.
