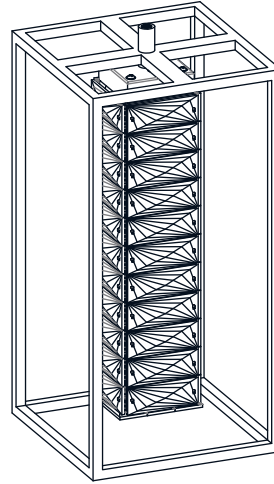

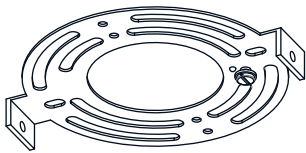

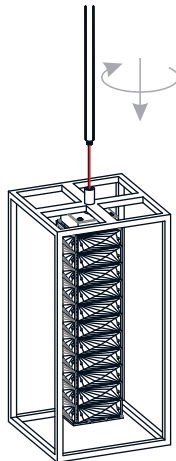

1 Install Rods

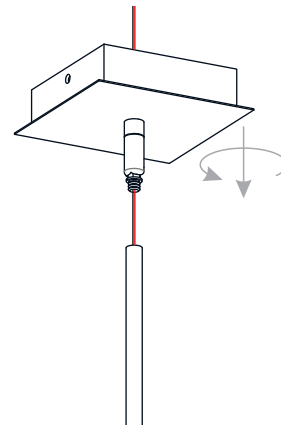
Optional Rods:

(1) 6"L Rod + (1) 12"L Rod.
- 9 Feet Ceiling:
(1) 6"L Rod + (2) 12"L Rods.
- 10 Feet Ceiling:
(2) 6"L Rods + (2) 12"L Rods.



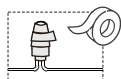

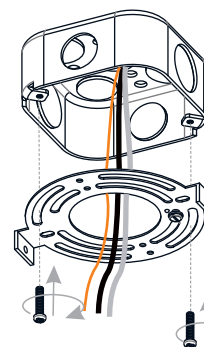

Wiring
