Attach the Daybed Leg (E) to the Left Arm (B) and Right Arm (C), turn the legs and tighten them in a clockwise direction.



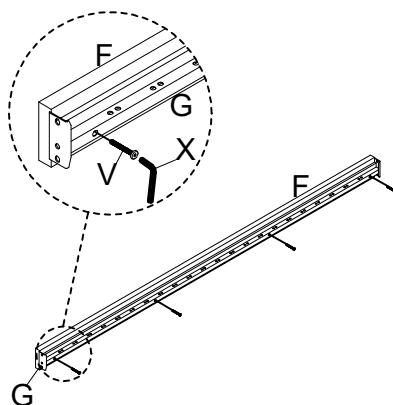

Cleaning & Care
