STORY

Coming from a “Vieilles Vignes” parcel (60 years old), “Les Ouvrées Rodin” is characterised by its elegant tannins and delicate structure.

Marthe Sirieys, Erwan Faiveley’s great grandmother, had family links with art amateur Maurice Fenaille. In 1885, the latter became Auguste Rodin’s patron. In memory of the unique relationship with Auguste Rodin and as a homage to the timeless works created by him, we named this new gem of the Côte de Nuits: “Les Ouvrées Rodin”

WINE NOTES

Fermentation:	Partial whole cluster fermentation with daily punch downs for a 19 day vatting period
Barrel-Aged:	16-18 months in French oak barrels- 60% new oak
Fining & Filtration:	No fining and, light filtration using the lenticular module process
Alcohol:	13.5%

TASTING NOTES

Deep ruby red hue with purplish glimmers. The complex nose offers a combination of fruit, spice and floral notes. The lively palate displays exceptional tension, elegant tannins, a hint of white pepper and menthol notes. Les Ouvrées Rodin is an intense, deep, smooth, elegant and subtle wine and a perfect reflection the character of its historical terroir.
