Do not use without umbrella base weights.

Recommended Weight: >200 lbs.

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() NOTICE

Please retain these instructions for future reference.

- · This product is intended for residential use only.
- Umbrella base weights are not included. Do not use without umbrella base weights (recommended weight: >200 lbs.).
- · Place umbrella on a stable and level surface.
- Umbrella is suitable for rain showers and light wind.
- Do not use umbrella in inclement weather, such as snow, heavy rain, thunderstorms, or strong wind.
- Firmly secure all bolts, screws and knobs before use.
- Reconfirm that all bolts, screws, and knobs are secure every 90 days.
- Fasten screws loosely during initial assembly. Do not firmly tighten the screws until the item is completely assembled.
- Be aware that some parts are heavy and have sharp edges.
- If any parts are missing, broken, damaged, or worn, stop using this product until repairs are made and/or factory replacement parts are installed.
- Do not use this item in a way inconsistent with the manufacturer's instructions as this could void the product warranty.

BATTERY WARNINGS

The following safety hazards may result in serious injury or death:

- Do not mix alkaline, standard (Carbon Zinc) and rechargeable (Nickel Cadmium, Nickel Metal Hydride, or Lithium Ion) batteries.
- To optimize lifespan, remove battery from product if it will not be used for an extended period of time.
- · Do not mix old and new batteries.
- Do not attempt to charge non-rechargeable batteries as this may result in rupture or leakage and cause personal injury or property damage.

- Batteries should be inserted with the correct polarity (+ -).







BEFORE FIRST USE


- 1. Hold the part F umbrella upside down and shake gently to separate the umbrella ribs. If necessary, carefully pull the ribs apart to free them.
- 2. Insert and secure the part I crank handle into the crank mechanism on the part F umbrella.
- 3. Slowly turn the crank to open the umbrella. Make sure that the ribs are not stuck together.



PRODUCT ASSEMBLY




Insert the part A crossbar into the part B crossbar and set aside.

Locate the part C rotator base and attach the part D foot pedal with one part 1 bolt.


NOTE: the bolt attaches through the bottom of the foot pedal.



Press down on the pedal to rotate the base and expose the lower mounting holes. Overlay the rotator base with the crossbars.

Attach the part C rotator base to the part A & B crossbars with four part 2 screws and four part 3 washers.




PRODUCT ASSEMBLY



Fill the part J & K base weights with your choice of sand or water. (DO NOT MIX sand with water)






Place the base weights over the crossbar assembly, place the part K weights closest to the part C rotator base and the part J weights on the outside.

Slide the part E rotator plate over the part C base.


NOTE: Make sure the pedal can articulate through the plate opening


Insert the battery connector from the part F umbrella into the part G solar panel. Screw the solar panel onto the top of the pole.



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
Remove the knob on the part C rotator base.

Firmly place the ${\bf part} \; {\bf F} \; {\bf umbrella}$ onto the ${\bf part} \; {\bf C} \; {\bf rotator} \; {\bf base}.$ Reinsert and tighten the knob to secure.




OPENING THE CANOPY

- 1. Grip and squeeze the handle to engage the release. Move the arm up.
- 2. Release the handle to lock the canopy in your desired position.
- 3. Slowly turn the crank to open the canopy.




ADJUSTING THE TILT

- 1. Grip and squeeze the handle and move the arm up/down to adjust the tilt angle of the umbrella.
- 2. Lock it in your desired position by releasing the handle.
- 3. Step firmly onto the part D foot pedal to rotate the canopy as needed




TURNING ON THE LIGHTS




CLOSING THE CANOPY

• Turn the crank counterclockwise to close the canopy.



STORAGE

- Close the canopy when umbrella is not in use.
- Grip the handle and move the arm all the way down, then secure the umbrella with the attached touch fastener.
- Slide the part H cover support into the part L umbrella cover, then unzip the cover.
- Slide the cover over the umbrella canopy and secure with the zipper.
- Store in a dry area shielded from the weather.



CHARGING THE LIGHTS

- Solar panel requires 6 to 7 hours of direct sunlight to fully charge.
- LED lights last for 6 to 7 hours on a single charge.
- If lights are not working, fully charge the solar panel and try again.

CLEANING

- Wipe clean with mild detergent, warm water, and a soft cloth.
- Do not use abrasive materials or cleaners.

PRODUCT WARRANTY INFORMATION
