OWNER'S MANUAL

1. **Read this manual carefully before starting assembly.** Read each step completely before beginning each step.
2. **Some smaller parts may be shipped inside larger parts. Check inside all parts and cartons before assembling or ordering parts.**
3. If hardware is tightened too soon, mounting holes may not align and parts may not easily fit together. Leave bolts slightly loose until you are instructed to tighten them.
4. **Tools required for assembly:** Allen Wrench T1 & Wrench T2 (not included), 10mm Wrench is helpful and Phillips Screwdriver.
5. **An electric screwdriver is recommended in assembly. However, please set at low torque and use extreme caution with an electric screwdriver because you could overtighten the hardware and strip the screws.**
6. To make assembly as easy as possible, place all parts of the table tennis table in a cleared area and remove the packaging material. Organize all parts as per parts identifier in the assembly manual. Do not dispose of the packing material until assembly is completed.
7. Avoid scratching table tennis top and metal tube parts during the assembly process.
8. Assemble product on a clean, level and flat surface.
9. **Take time to correctly orientate parts exactly as each assembly diagram.**
10. **Save this manual in the event that the manufacturer has to be contacted for replacement parts.**

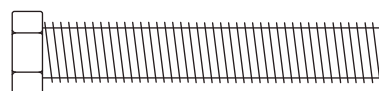

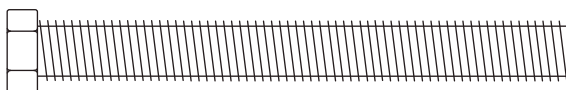

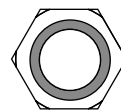

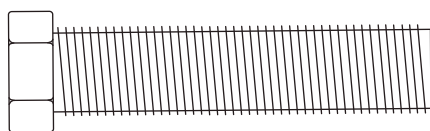

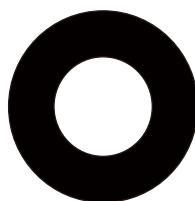

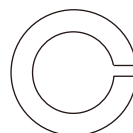

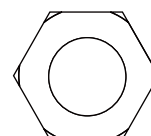

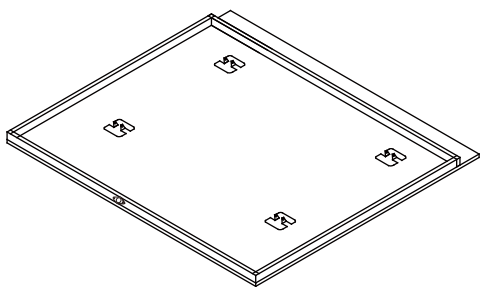

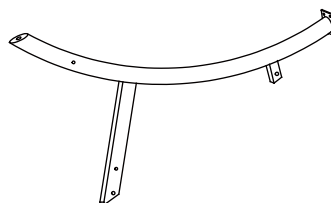

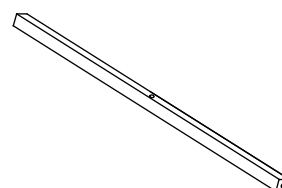

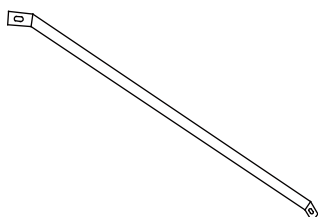
P1 - Table Tennis Table Top

(2 pcs)



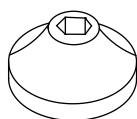
P2 - Leg (4 pcs)



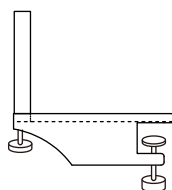
P3 - Leg Support Tube

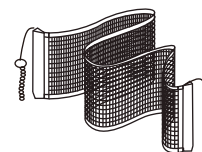

PARTS REQUIRED

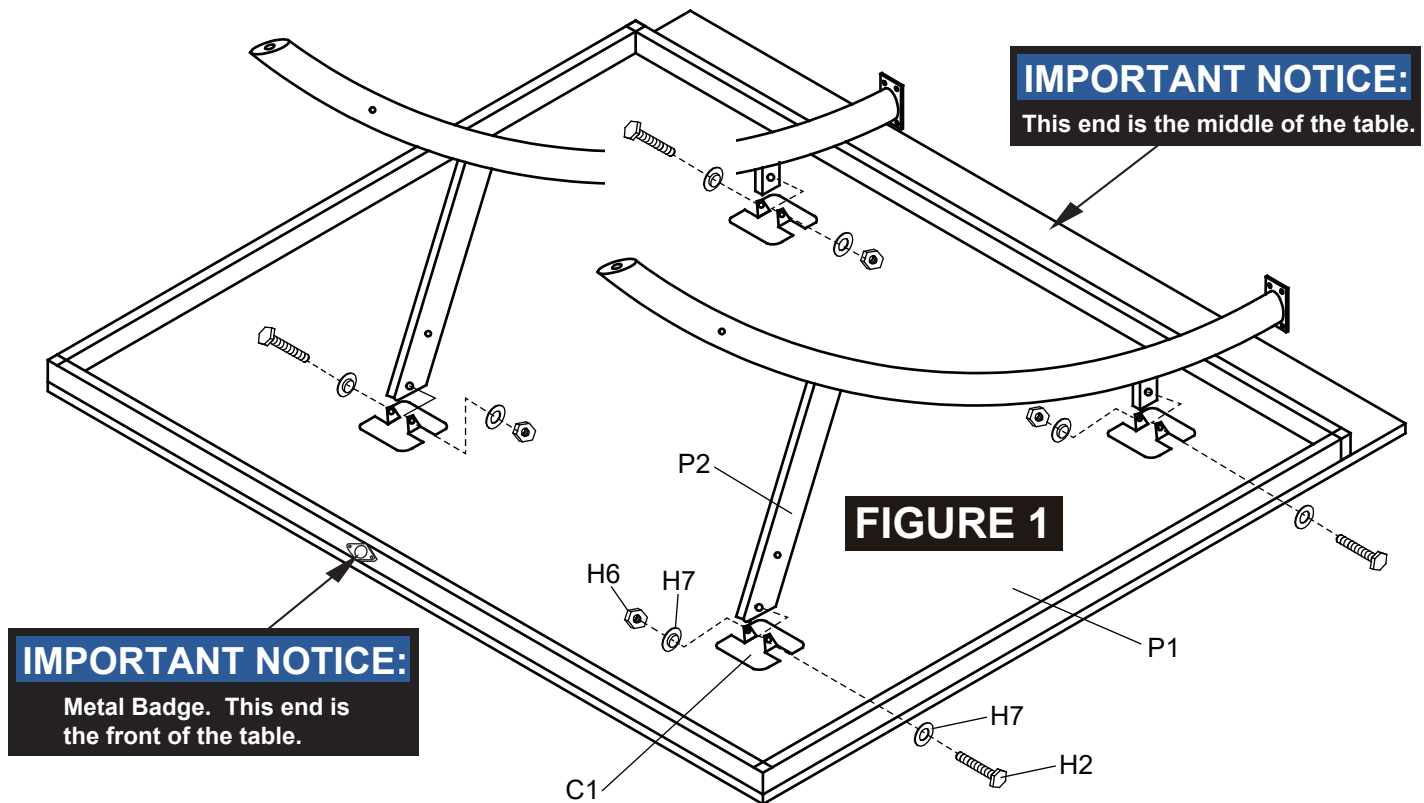
- 1 pc - **P1** Table Tennis Table Top and Frame Assembly
- 2 pcs - **P2** Leg
- 4 pcs - **H2** 8x40mm Hex Head Bolt
- 4 pcs - **H6** 8mm Nylon Lock Nut
- 8 pcs - **H7** Plastic Step Washer

STEP 1:

Lay one piece **P1** Table Tennis Table Top and Frame Assembly flat with playing surface facing down as shown in **FIGURE 1**. Install **P2** Legs using **H2** Bolts with **H7** Step Washers and **H6** Nuts as shown in **FIGURE 1**.

IMPORTANT NOTICE:

DO NOT TIGHTEN H2 BOLTS & H6 NUTS ON THIS STEP.



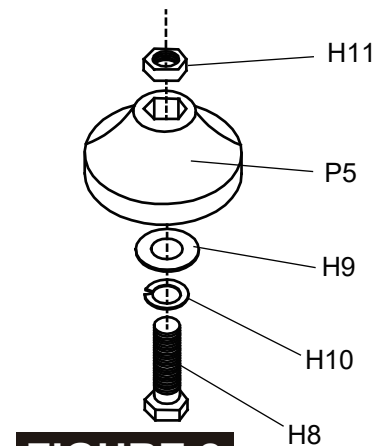
PARTS REQUIRED

- 4 pcs - **P5** Leg Leveler
- 4 pcs - **H8** 12x50mm Hex Head Bolt
- 4 pcs - **H9** 12mm Flat Washer
- 4 pcs - **H10** M12 Lock Washer
- 4 pcs - **H11** 12mm Nut

STEP 2:

Install **H8** Bolt with **H10** Lock Washer, **H9** Washer and **H11** Nut onto **P5** Leg Leveler as shown in **FIGURE 2**. Tighten, but do not overtighten.

Repeat procedure for the other three **P5** Leg Levelers.



PARTS REQUIRED

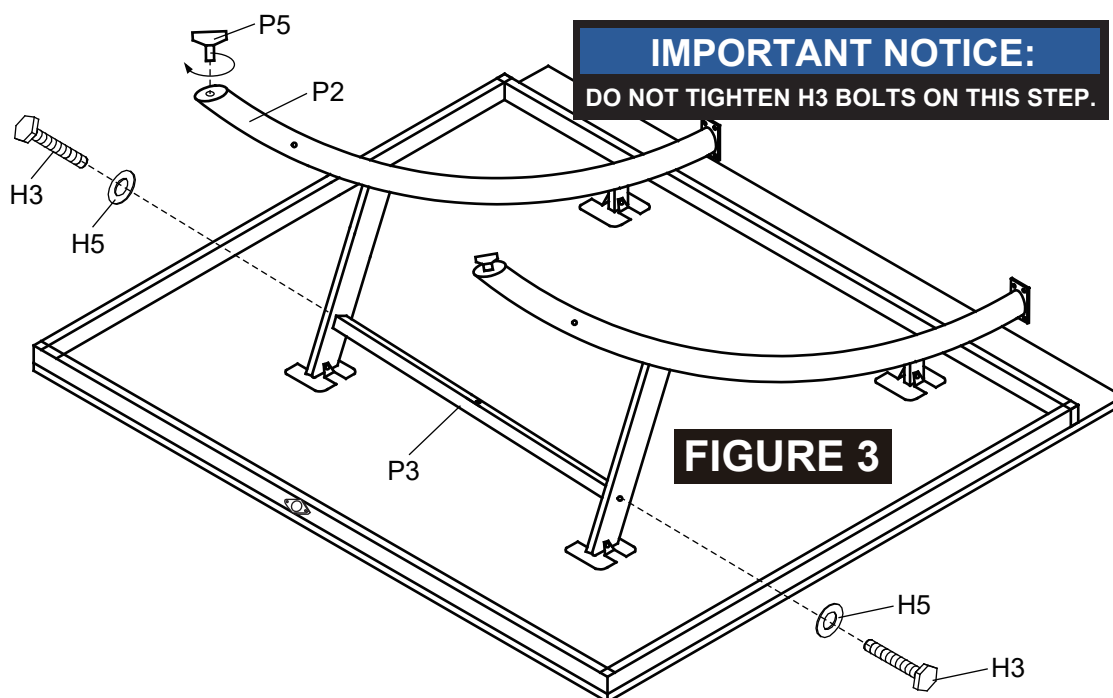
1 pc - **P3** Leg Support Tube

2 pcs - **H3** 8x45mm Hex Head Bolt

2 pcs - **H5** Flat Washer

STEP 3:

Install **P3** Tube using **H3** Bolts with **H5** Flat Washers as shown in **FIGURE 3**. **DO NOT TIGHTEN H3 BOLTS ON THIS STEP.** Thread **P5** Leg Levelers assembly from **STEP 2** onto the **P2** Legs as shown in **FIGURE 3**.



PARTS REQUIRED

1 pc - **P4** Leg Support Brace

1 pc - **H3** 8x45mm Hex Head Bolt
2 pcs - **H4** 8x70mm Hex Head Bolt

6 pcs - **H5** Flat Washer
3 pcs - **H6** Lock Nut

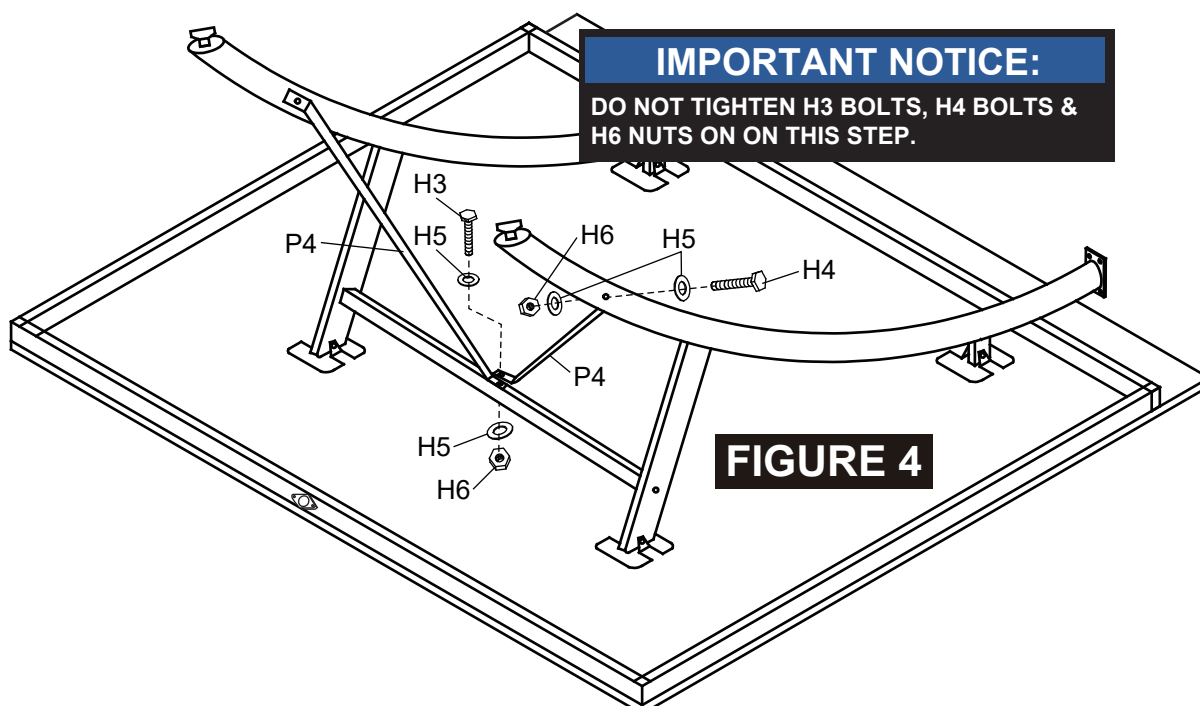
STEP 4:

Install **P4** Leg Support Brace using **H4** Bolts with **H5** Flat Washers and **H6** Lock Nuts as shown in **FIGURE 4**.

Install **P4** Leg Support Brace using **H3** Bolt with **H5** Flat Washers and **H6** Lock Nut as shown in **FIGURE 4**.

DO NOT TIGHTEN H3 BOLTS, H4 BOLTS AND H6 NUTS ON THIS STEP.

REPEAT PROCEDURE FROM STEP 1 TO STEP 4 FOR OTHER HALF TABLE TOP.



PARTS REQUIRED

8 pcs - **H1** 8x20mm Hex Head Bolt

16 pcs - **H5** Flat Washer

8 pcs - **H6** Lock Nut

STEP 5:

Connect two Half Tabletops using **H1** Bolts with **H5** Flat Washers and **H6** Lock Nuts as shown in **FIGURE 5** and **DETAIL A**. **MAKE SURE TABLE HALVES ARE ALIGNED AND FLAT BEFORE ATTACHING & TIGHTENING H1 BOLTS & H6 NUTS ON THIS STEP 5.**

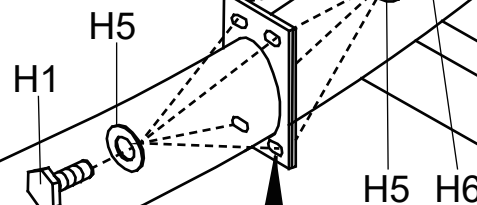

DETAIL A

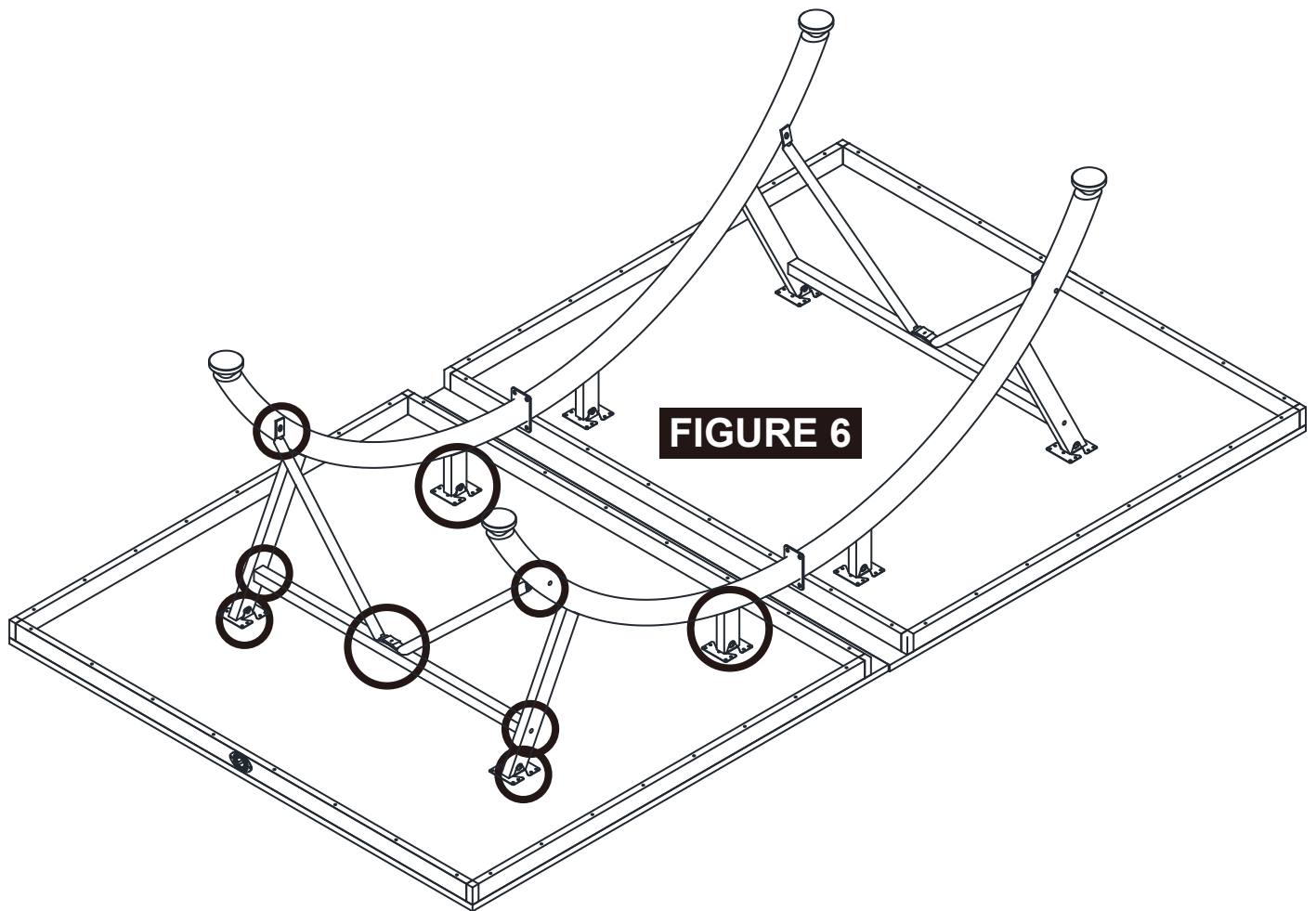

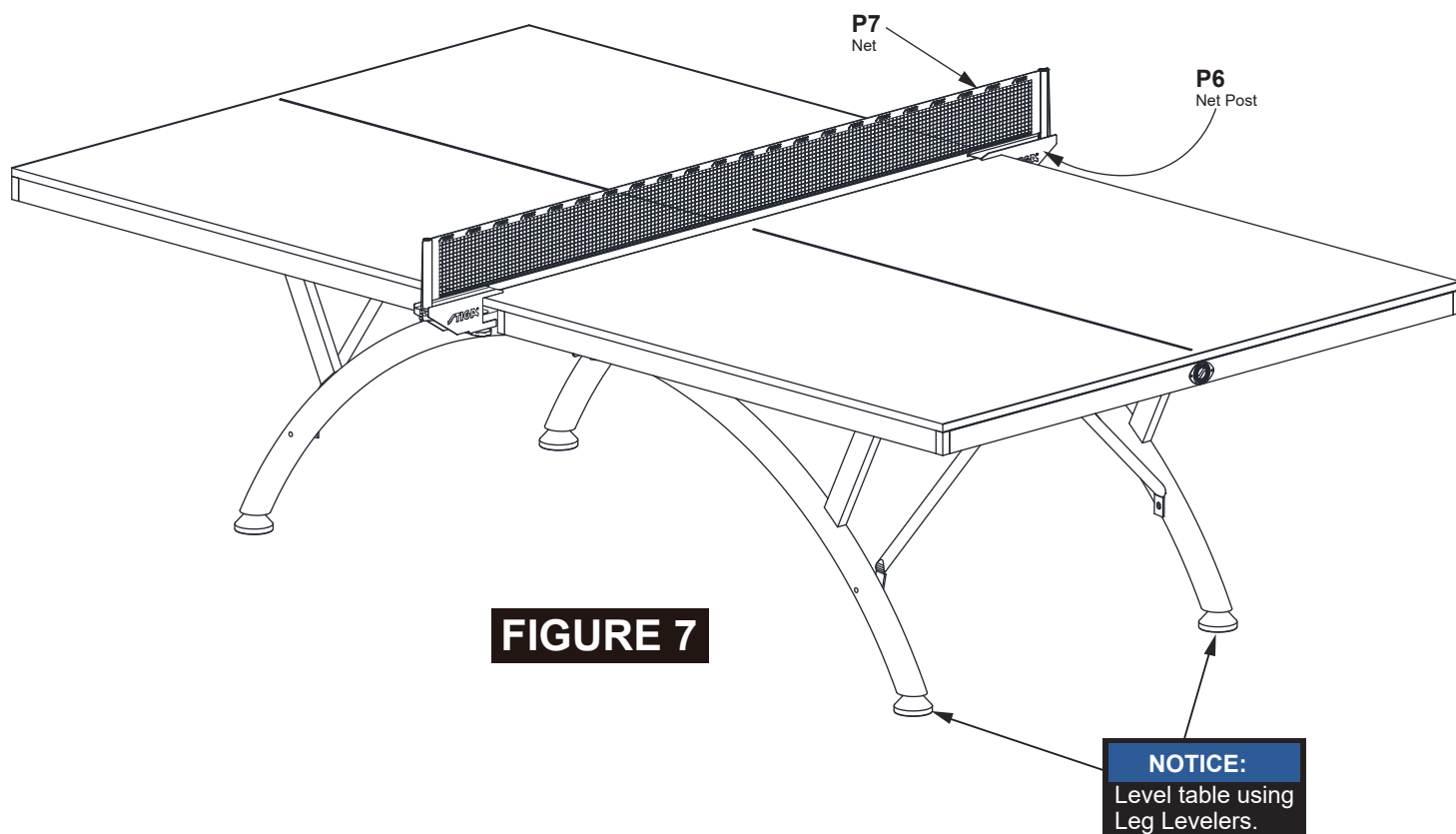
2 pcs - **P6** Net Post
1 pc - **P7** Net

STEP 7:

With the help of other capable adults, carefully turn the table over and set it on its legs.

Attach one **P6** Net Post to the middle edge of where the table halves meet. Repeat this with other **P6** Net Post on opposite side.

Then, slide **P7** Net into corresponding **P6** Net Post and repeat for the other side. Make sure the net tape is on top. Use strings at either end of the **P7** Net to tighten the net and attach to base of net post securely.

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

You have purchased a quality product that will give you years of enjoyment. By following these simple maintenance steps, you will add to the life of your new table.

THE TABLE TOP

The top (playing surface) of your table is made of Mid-Density Board. Like all products made of wood, it can be affected by atmospheric changes in both temperature and humidity. This may cause a slight sag or distortion as the top expands or contracts. This is normal and should not cause concern as it does not detract from the play or utility value of the table. After assembly of the table, you can minimize the effects of temperature and humidity changes by storing the table in a dry area when table is not in use.

STORAGE OF YOUR TABLE

This table must be stored indoors to prevent damage to the playing surface. Dampness and extreme temperature changes can cause the wood to warp, swell, crack or blister. When your table is not in use, it should be stored in a dry area. Due to the nature of particle board, table top may bow. Damp and humid conditions will amplify this. This is normal and will not affect playability of table.

CLEANING YOUR TABLE

To clean your table use a soft, damp (NOT WET) cloth only. To prevent damage to your table's playing surface, DO NOT USE ANY CHEMICALS, ABRASIVE OR CLEANING PRODUCTS on your table's playing surface.

MAINTENANCE OF YOUR TABLE

This table must be kept indoors to prevent damage to the playing surface. Dampness and extreme temperature changes which occur on patios or similar areas can cause wood to warp, swell, crack or blister.

UNEVEL FLOORS

If table does not seem level, it is probably due to uneven or unlevel floors. Set the table in its PLAYING POSITION and move table several inches in different directions to find the best location for the table. If the floor is extremely unlevel, table may not play or operate properly. The table has leg levelers - Adjust leg levelers as required.
