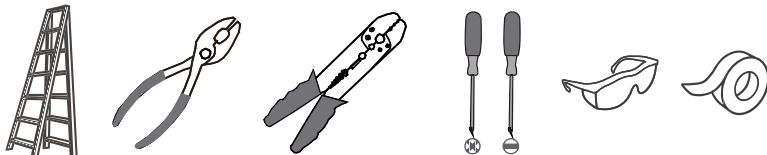

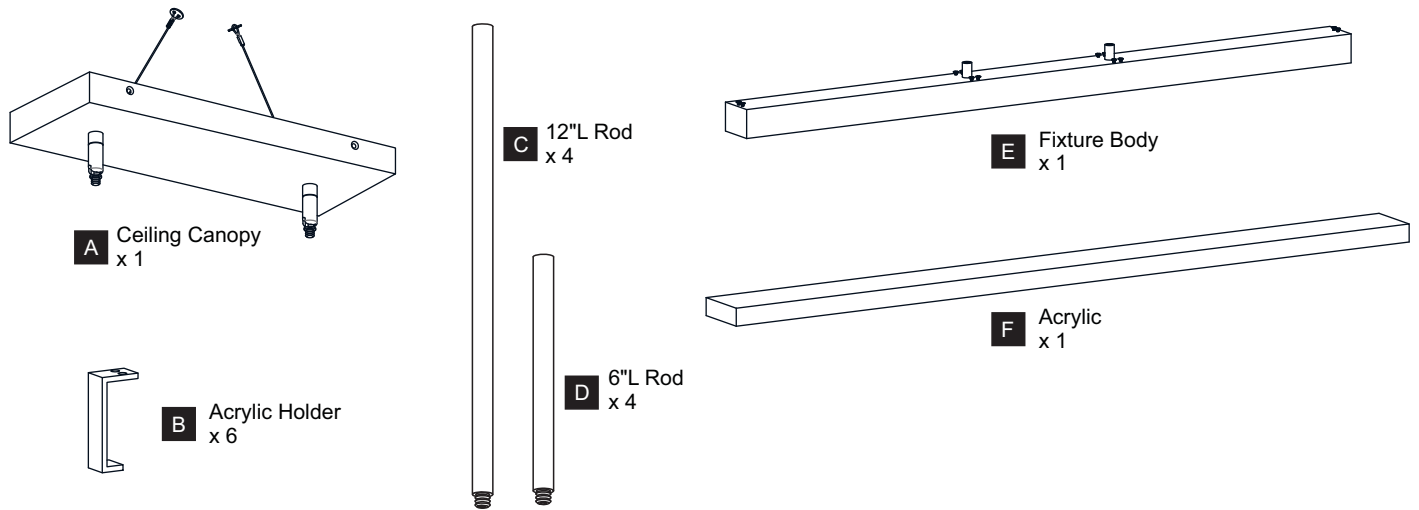

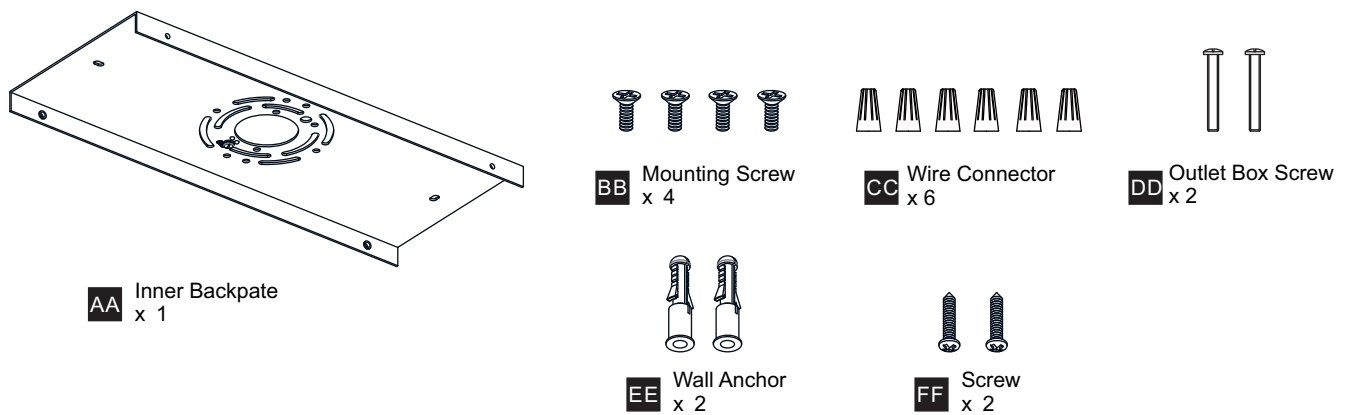
- Wipe clean using soft, dry cloth or static duster. Always avoid using harsh chemicals and abrasives to clean fixture as they may damage the finish.

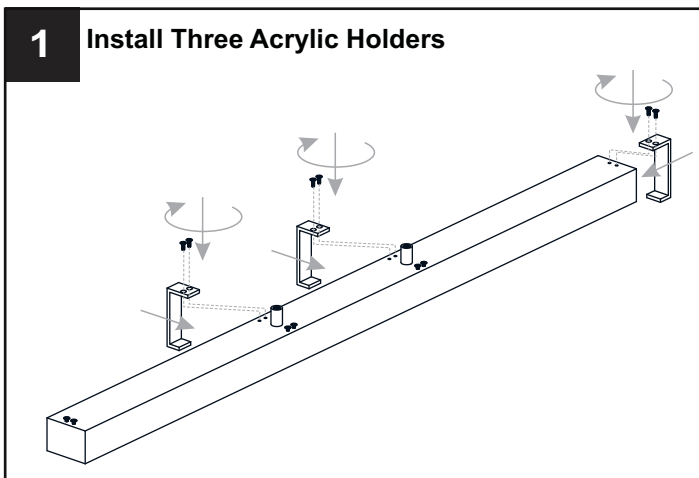

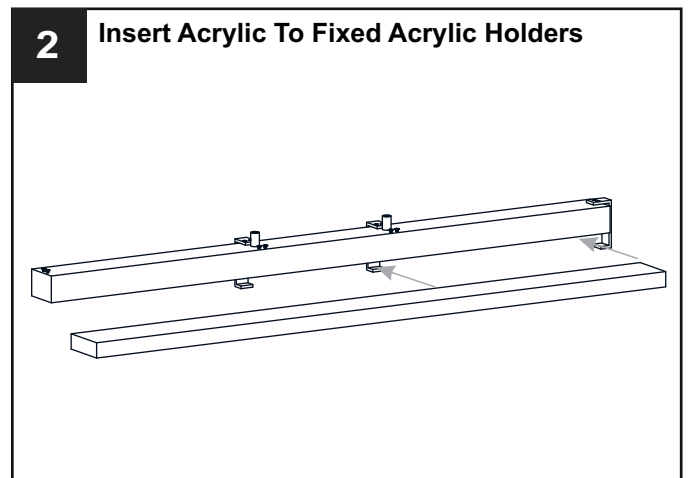

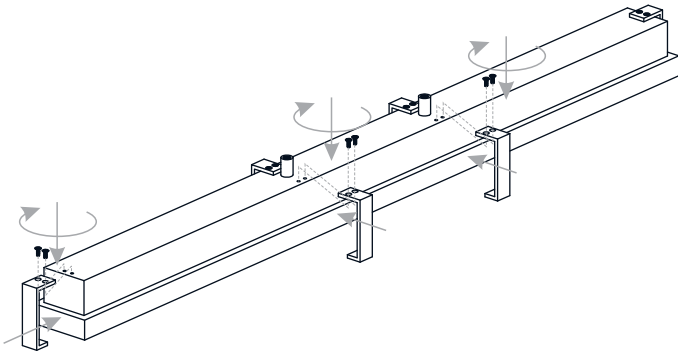
1 Install Three Acrylic Holders



2 Insert Acrylic To Fixed Acrylic Holders



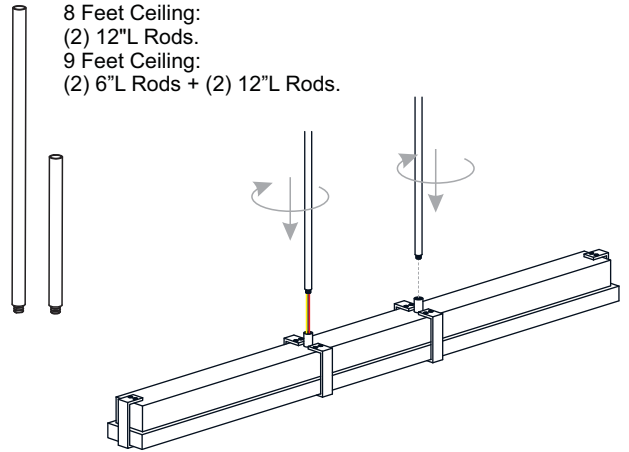
3 Secure Acrylic With Rest Acrylic Holders



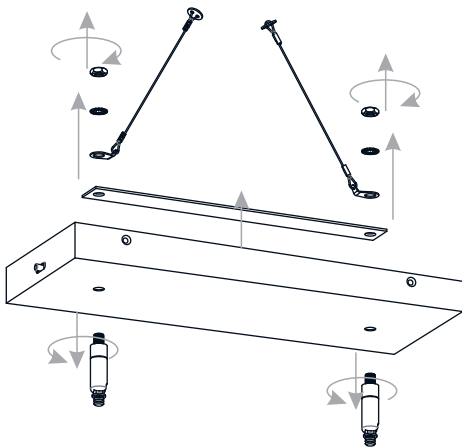
4 Install Rods

Optional Rods:

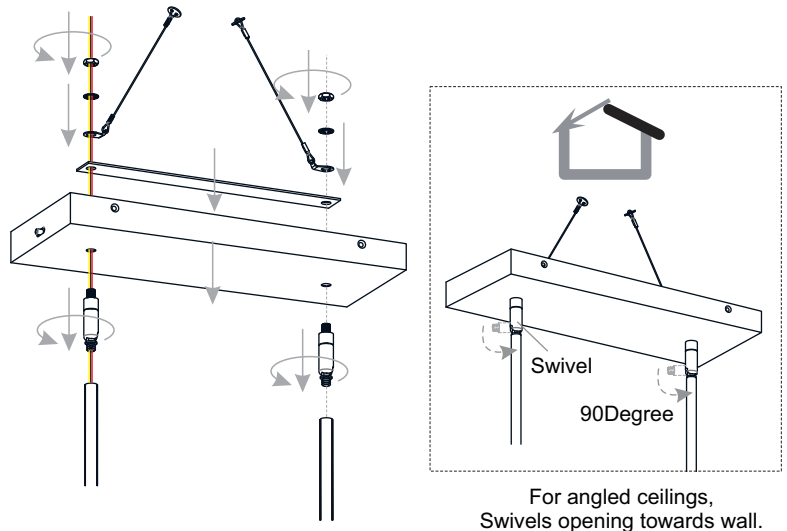
8 Feet Ceiling:

(2) 6"L Rods + (2) 12"L Rods.



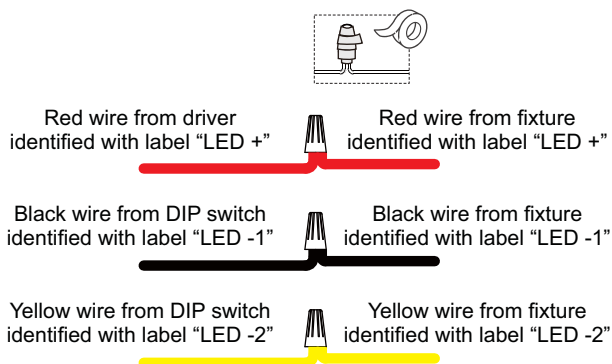
5 Separate Swivels From Ceiling Canopy



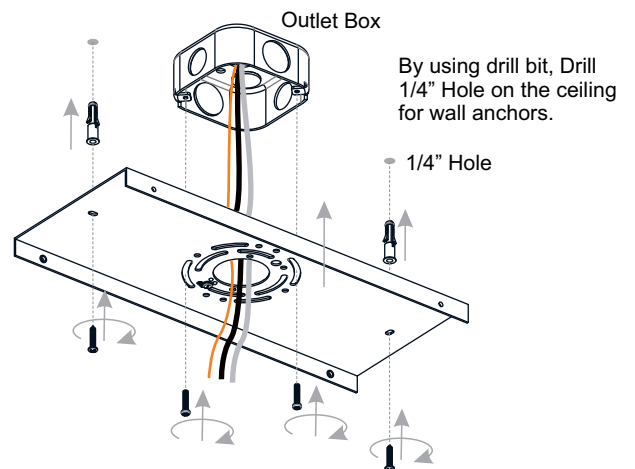
6 Install Swivels and Ceiling Canopy to Upper Rods



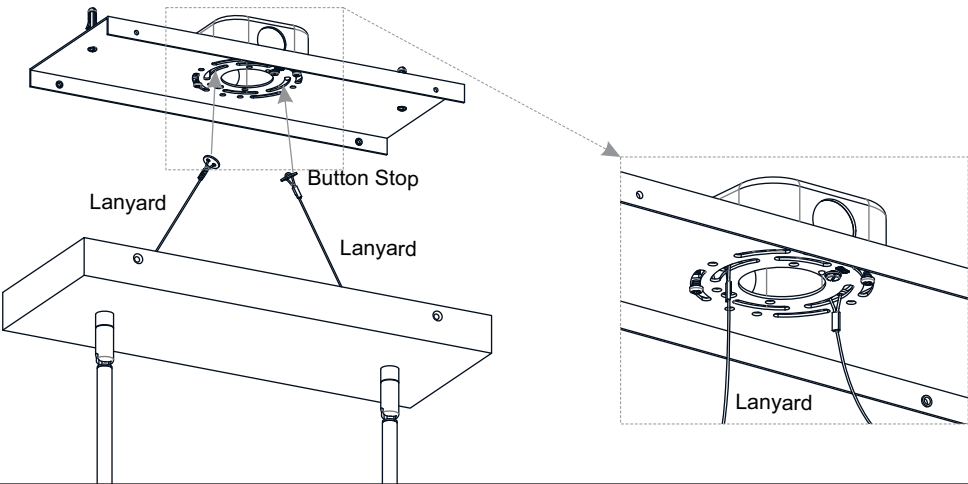
7 Connect Fixture Wires to Driver and DIP Switch



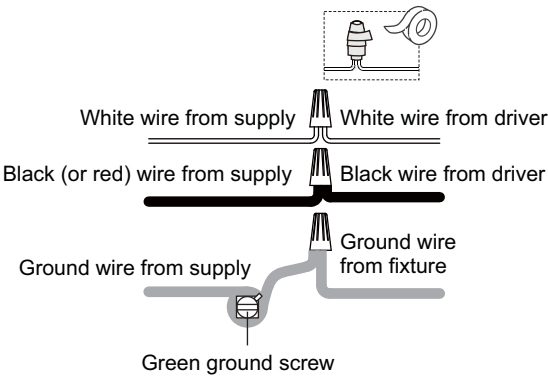
8 Install Inner Backplate



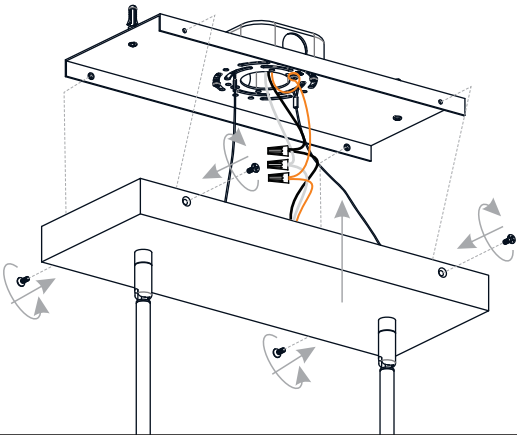
9 Install Lanyards



10 Wiring

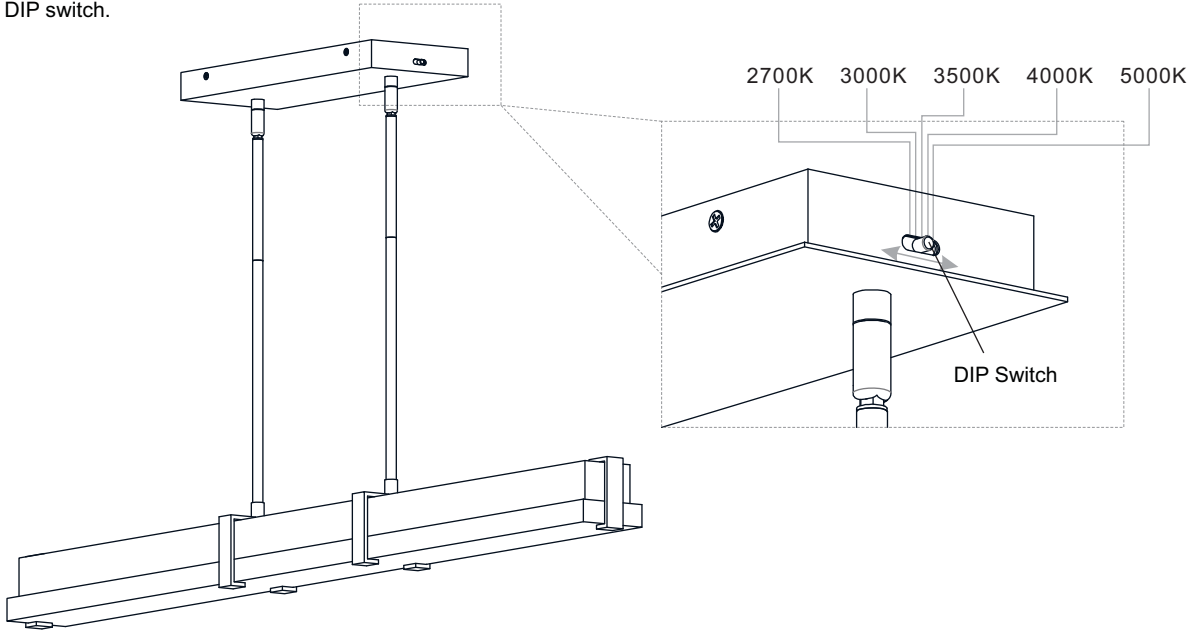


11 Install Ceiling Canopy to Inner Backplate
