Care and use

Before using the cookware for the first time, it is essential to hand-wash it thoroughly. The cookware is suitable for use on hobs only, including induction hobs. For optimal energy efficiency, ensure that the cookware is placed on hob rings that match its base size, and take care not to let flames extend over the sides or handles. To enhance the longevity of the cookware, it is recommended to utilise silicone, wooden, or nylon utensils, while avoiding the use of metal utensils. Additionally, do not overheat the cookware or allow it to boil dry, and never leave it unattended during use. Please note that the non-stick coating may discolour over time, although this does not affect the cookware's functionality. To prevent damage to ceramic hobs, always lift the cookware instead of dragging it across the hob surface, and remember that screws may loosen over time, necessitating retightening with a screwdriver. When cleaning and storing the cookware, always allow it to cool before washing. This cookware is not dishwasher safe; instead, hand-wash it using a mild detergent and a non-abrasive sponge, ensuring that it is rinsed and dried thoroughly. Do not store the cookware while it is wet. Always exercise caution by using heat-resistant oven gloves when moving the cookware and avoid exposing hot cookware to cold liquids. If any evidence of damage is found, dispose of the cookware carefully.
