


# Ensure appropriate Age and Weight




The Kitchen Helper is intended for children age 18 months+; Safely supports up to 125 lbs/56 kg


## Assembly Instructions

Applicable to all styles and sizes of Kitchen Helper.







Remove item from carton and fold out sides.




Fold platform down and rotate latches as shown in Diagram 1 to lock sides into place.




 $\operatorname{\mathsf{Clip}}\nolimits A$  is designed to lock down the platform when the Kitchen Helper is in use.




Clip B is a tension clip, and provides additional stabilization. It is not intended to clip over the platform.





# Adjusting the Platform



The Kitchen Helper is designed to be used at two different heights based on the age and height of a child. Once a child's waist is above the top of the Kitchen Helper, please adjust to the lower position.








Attach platform in lower position using bolt [2] as shown above.
