Glossary of Terms:

- **Payment Processor Dock** - The Finished stationary dock providing power and a mounting location for a Payment Processor Case
- **Payment Processor Case** - The removable housing providing charging and mounting for a payment processor.
- **Security Foot** - The metal removable portion of the Payment Processor Dock allowing for a secure mounting of the Payment Processor Dock when screwed to a solid surface.

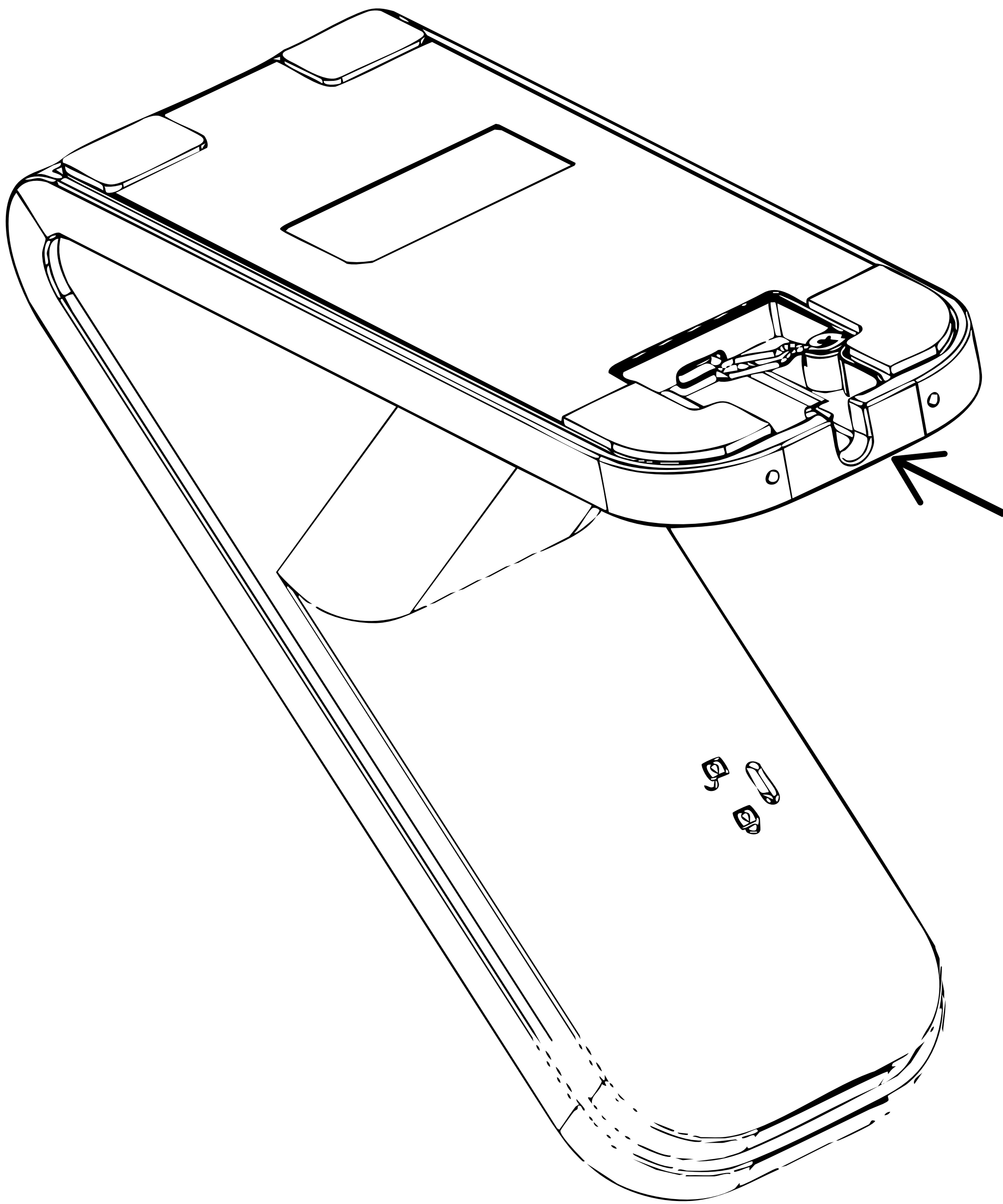
- 1. Remove the IPORT CONNECT PRO Payment Processor Dock and USB-C to A cable with USB-A Power supply from the box and place on a table.**

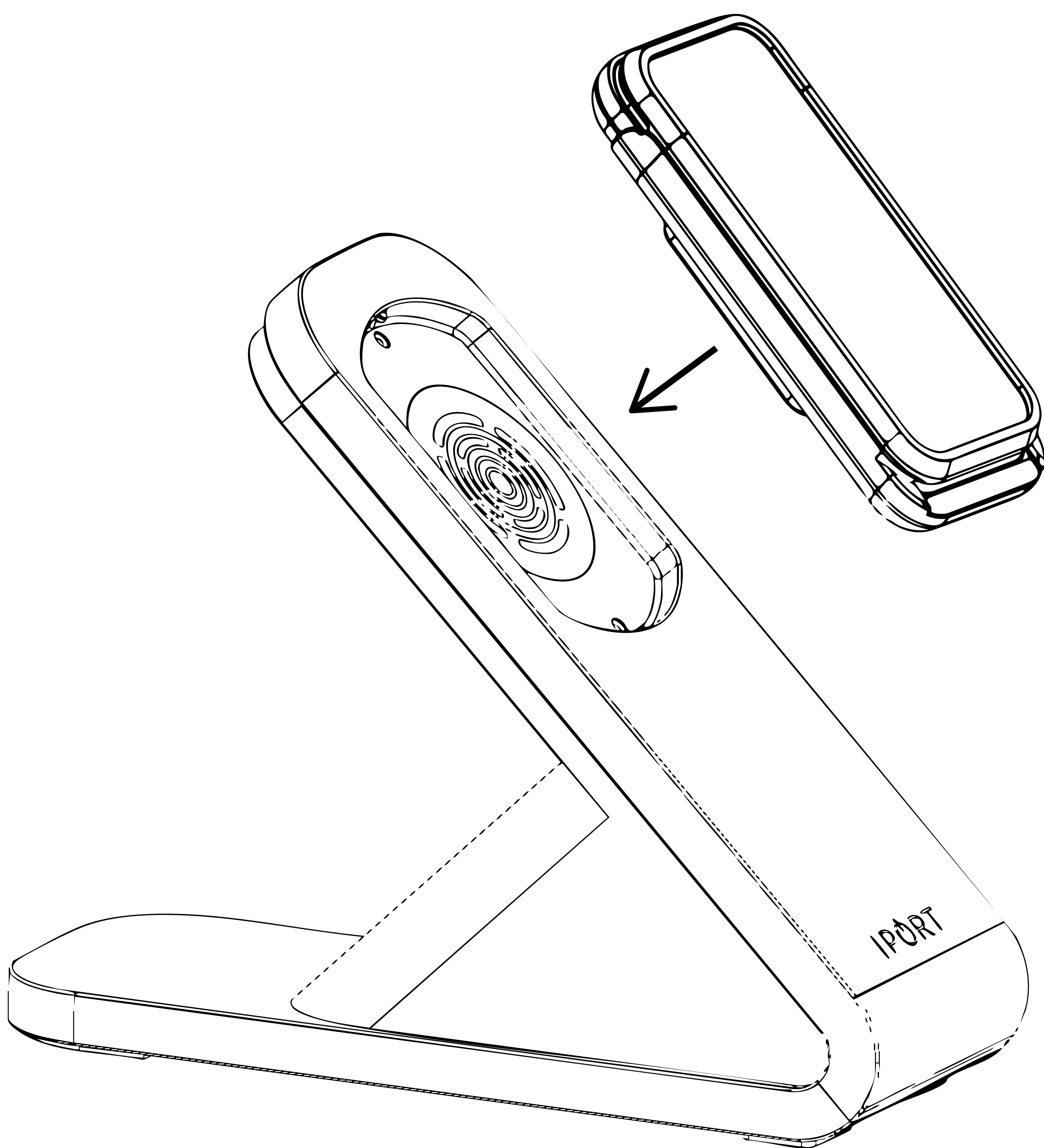

- 2. Plug in the USB-C Cable into the bottom of the IPORT Payment Processor Dock and the USB-A into the power Supply.**



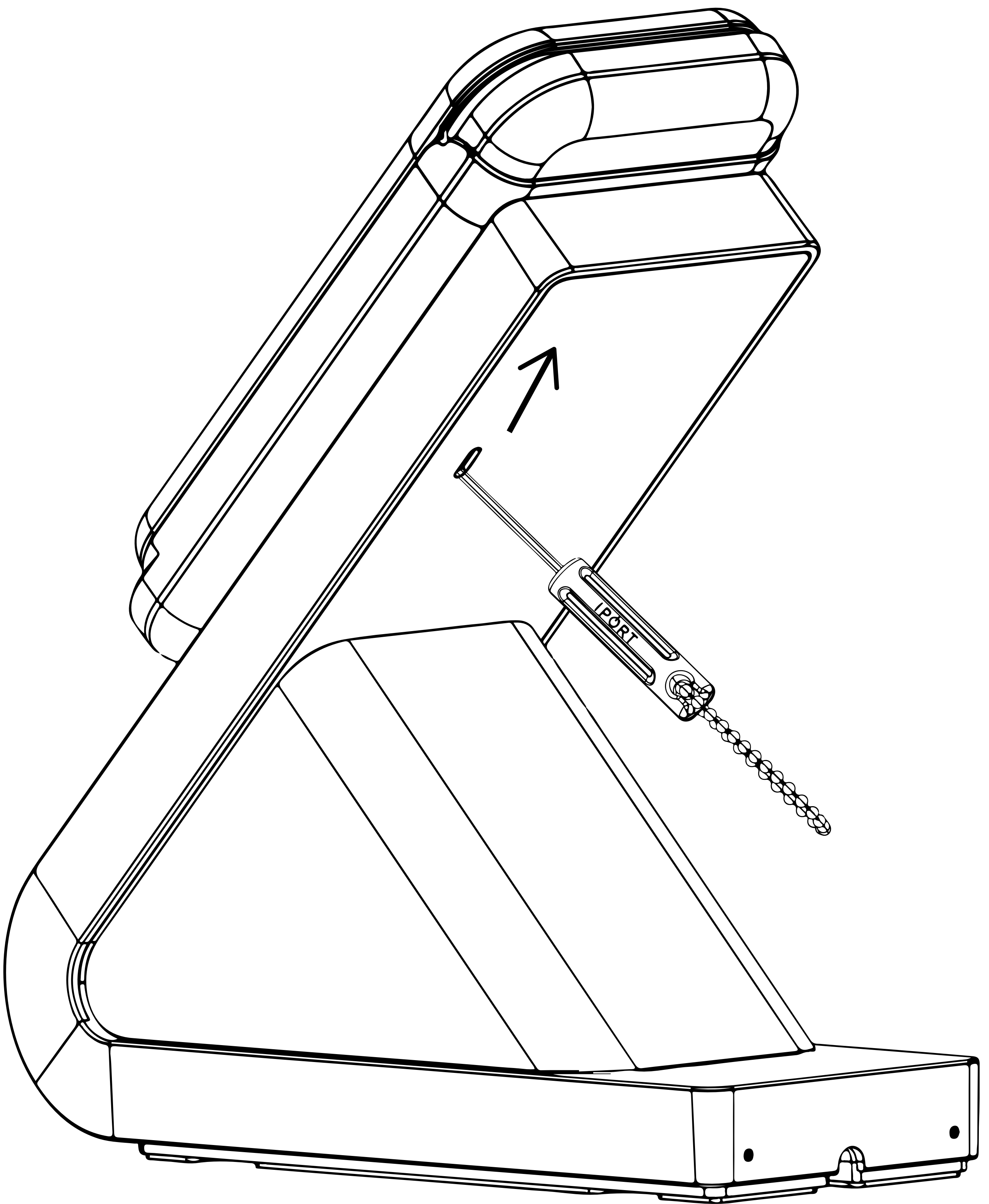

- 3. Place the Payment Processor Case onto the Dock to start charging.**



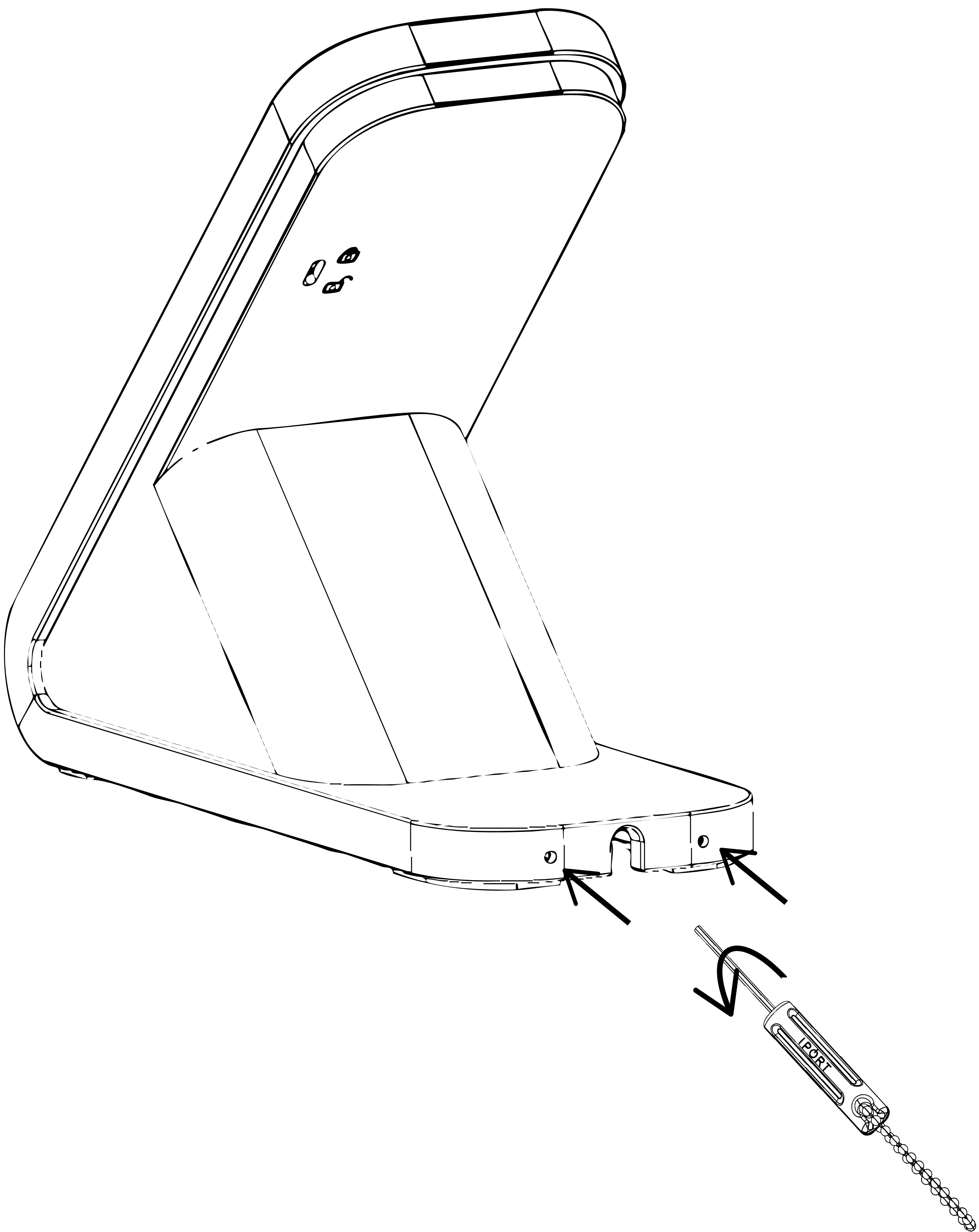

- 4. To lock the Case to the Dock, insert the IPORT Security tool into the back of the Dock and move the tool upward toward the top of the Dock**



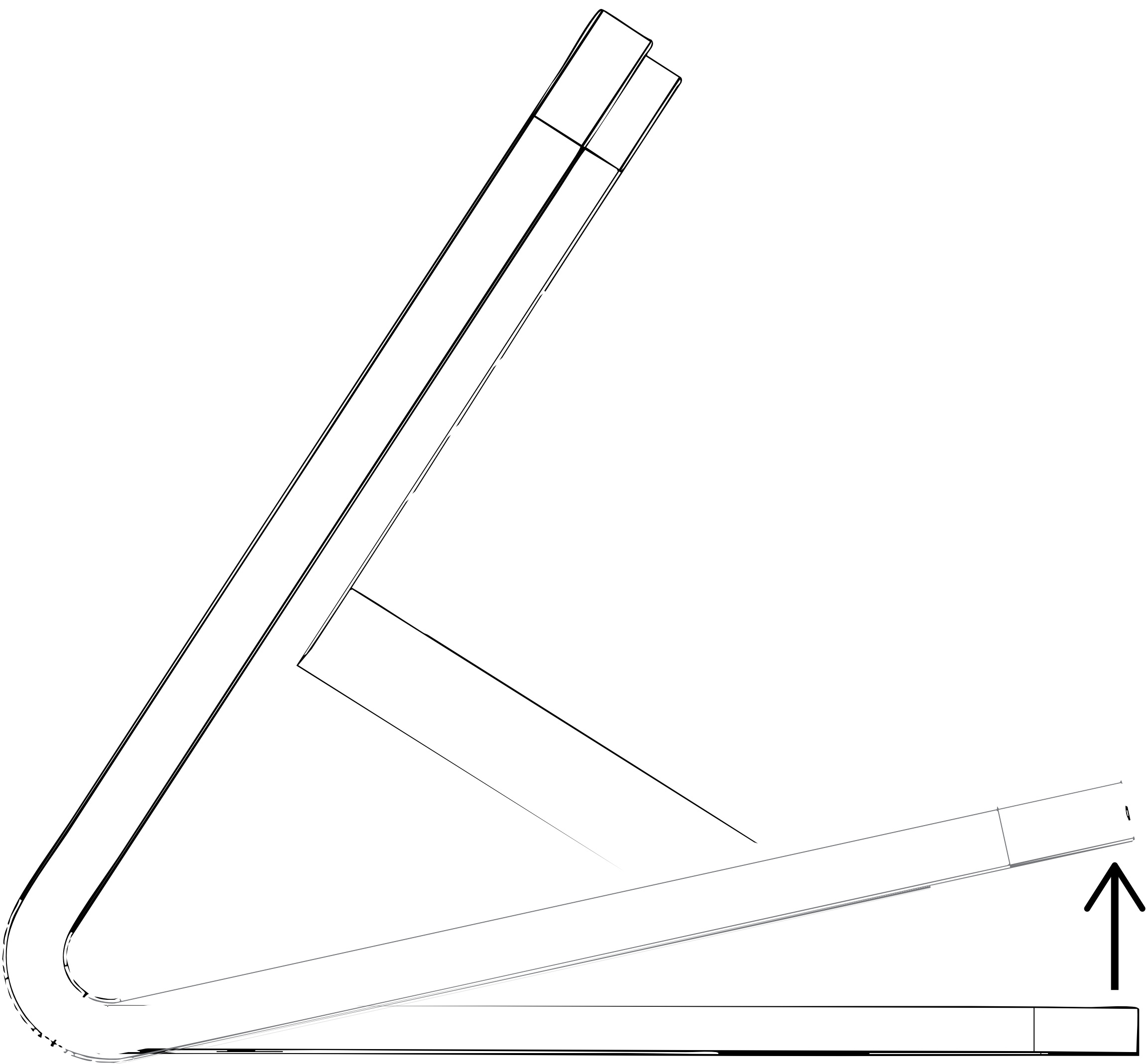
PAYMENT PROCESSOR DOCK

- 5. To secure the Payment Processor Dock to a table Insert the IPORT Security tool into the two holes in the back of the Payment Dock. Turn the IPORT Security tool counterclockwise to detach the Dock from the Security foot.**



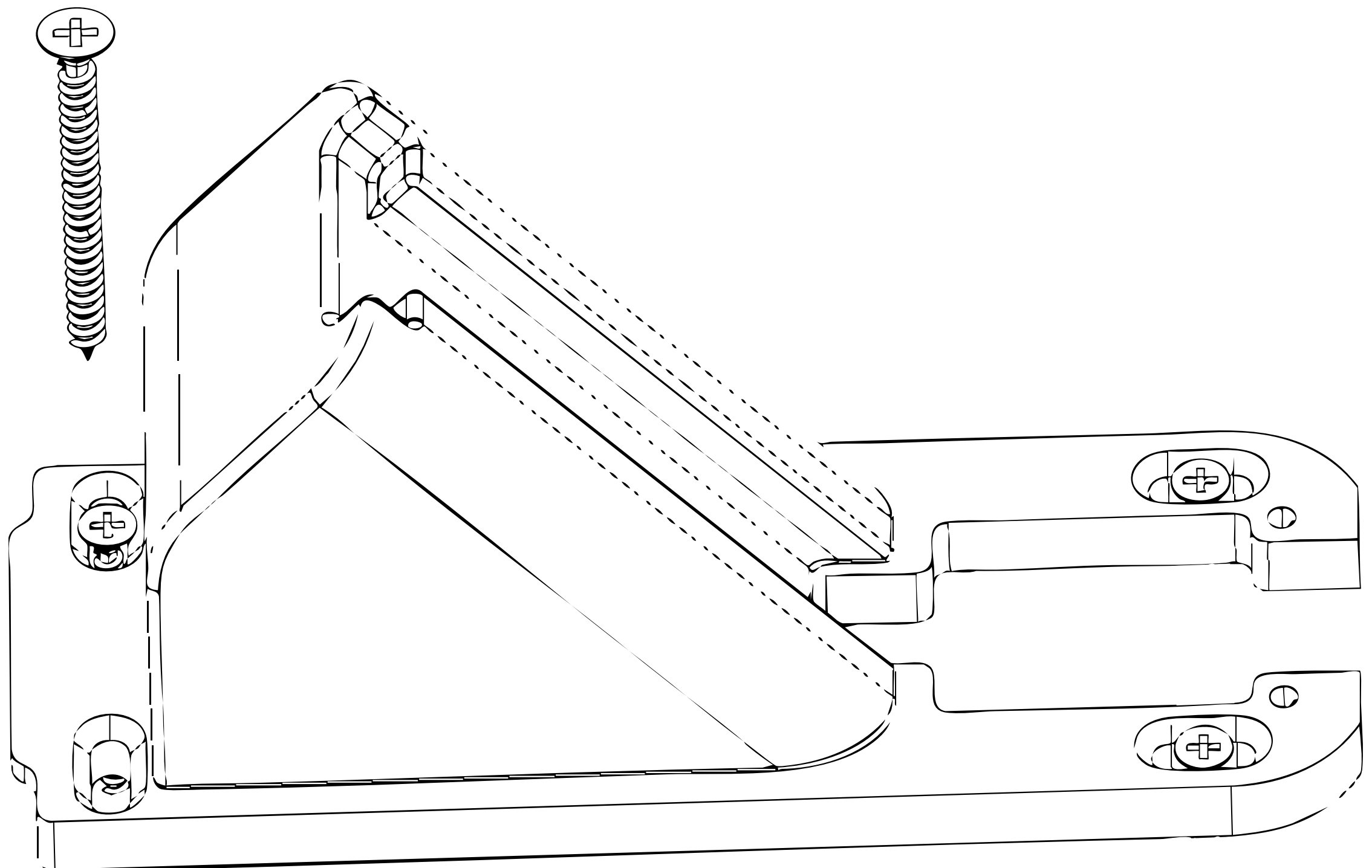

- 6. Lift the Payment Processor Dock off the security foot by rotating the Dock forward.**



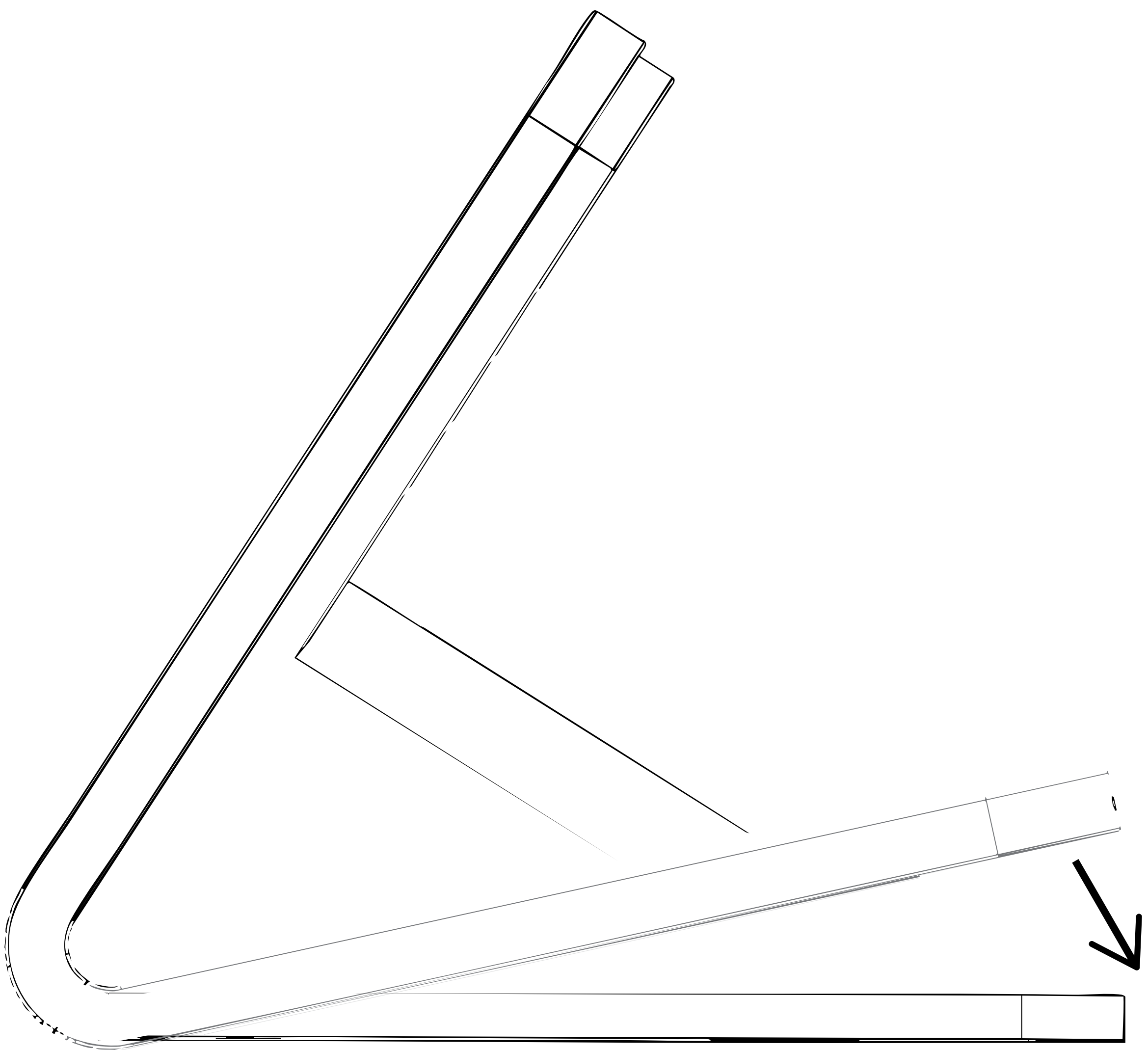

- 7. Attach the Security foot to a solid surface using the appropriate mounting hardware for the surface you are securing the Dock to.**



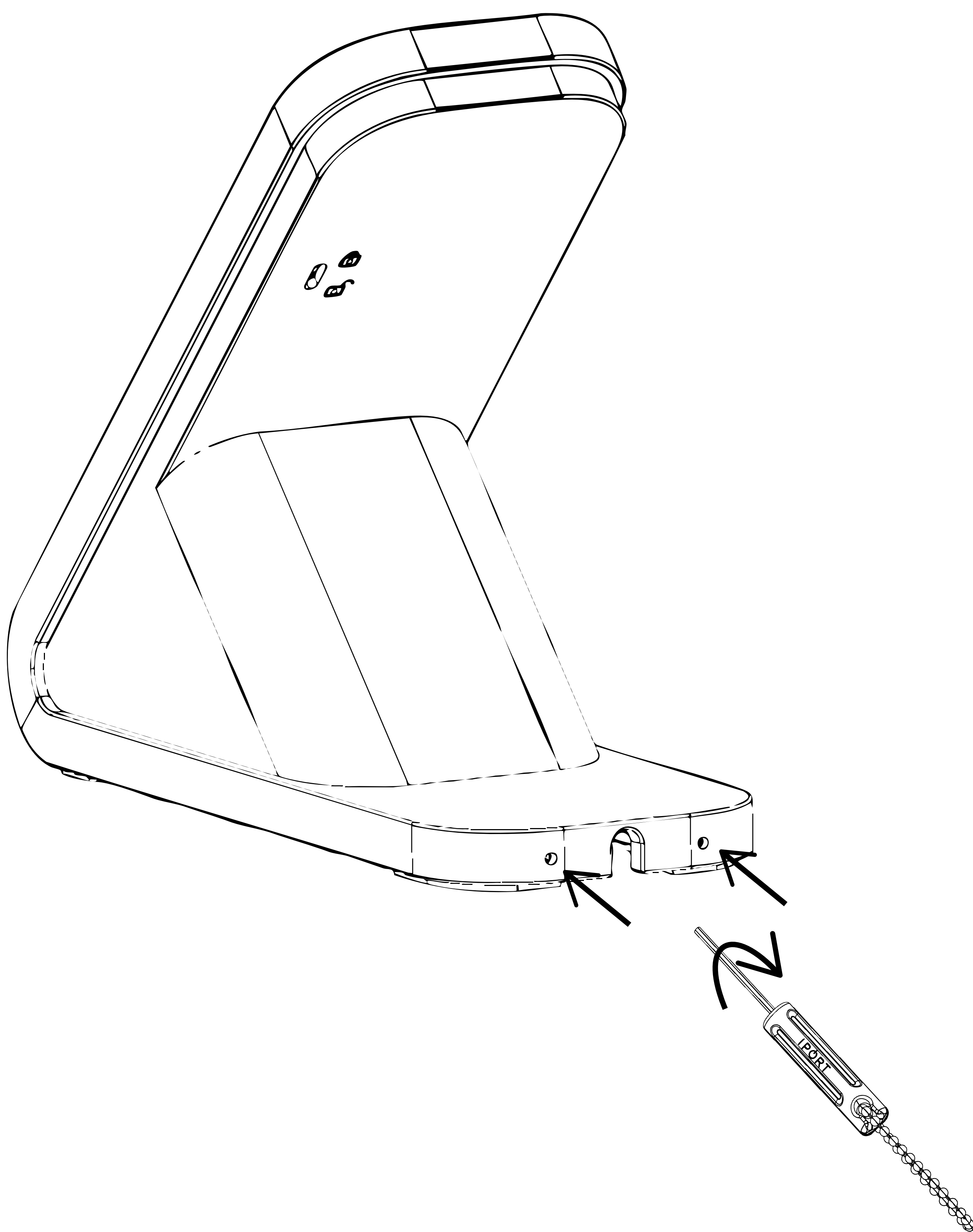

- 8. Reattach the Dock to the security foot making sure to hook the front of the Payment Dock under the front posts of the foot.**

- 9. Insert the IPORT Security tool into the two holes in the back of the Dock and turn clockwise to attach the Dock to the Security foot.**
