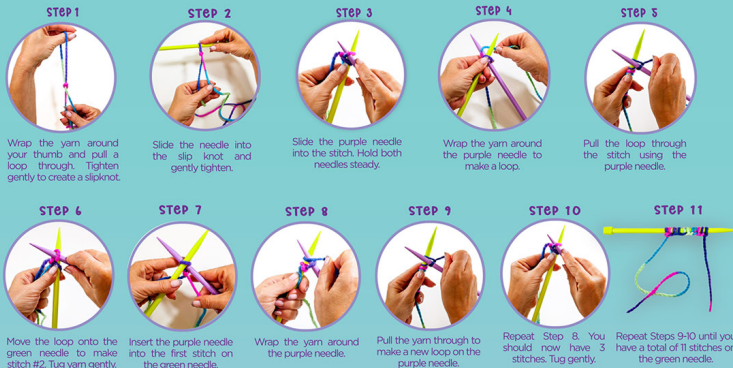

SCARF INSTRUCTIONS

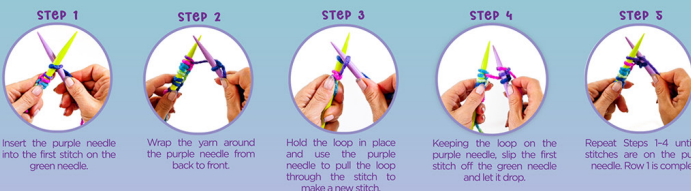
CASTING ON

To make the Scarf, the first step is to cast 11 stitches onto your green knitting needle. Just follow the steps to cast on:



START KNITTING!

Knit back and forth in rows. At the start of each row, move the needle with stitches to your left hand. Knit across, switch hands, and repeat. Left-handed? Mirror the steps.

HEADBAND INSTRUCTIONS

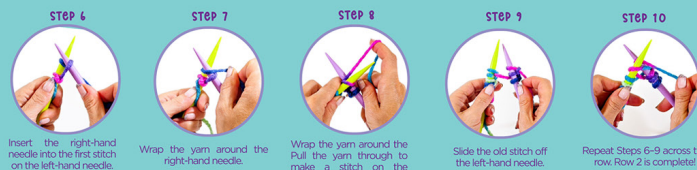
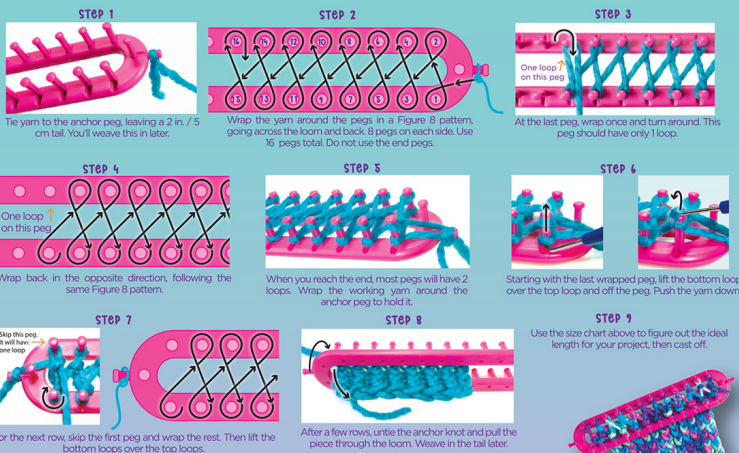

GETTING STARTED

Use fewer pegs for a thin headband or more pegs for a wide one. Check the size chart for the length.

CASTING ON

Use the Figure 8 weave to cast on. For this Headband, use 16 pegs total, 8 pegs on each side of the loom.



Repeat Steps 6-10 to continue knitting rows. At the end of every row, move the needle with the stitches on it to your left hand and hold the empty needle in your right hand.

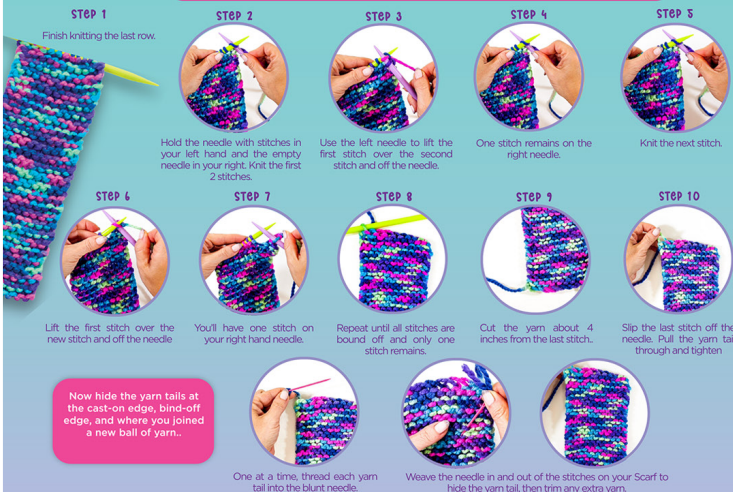
JOINING A NEW BALL OF YARN

When you have only a few inches of yarn left, add a new ball at the beginning of the next row.



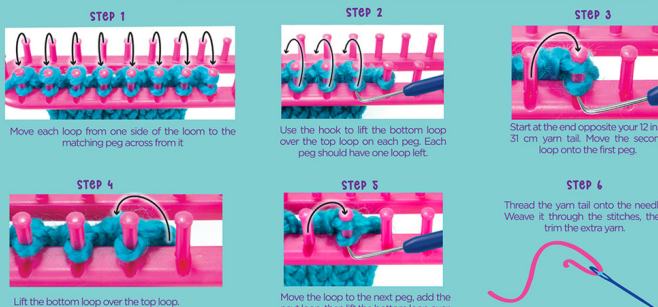
CASTING OFF

To finish your Scarf, you'll need to cast off the 11 stitches. Just follow the steps to cast off:



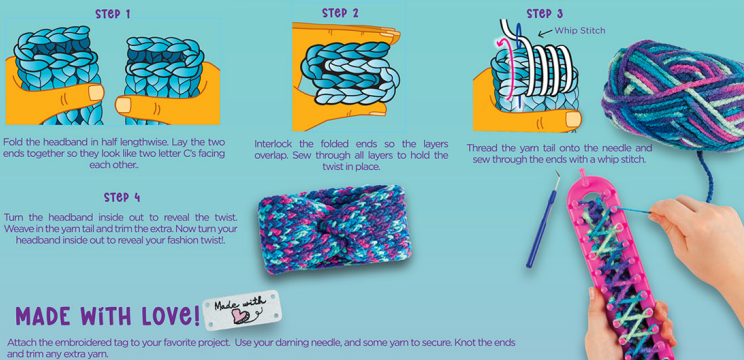
CASTING OFF

To finish your ear warmer you'll need to cast off the 8 stitches. Just follow the steps to cast off:



TWIST TECHNIQUE

This technique works best on wider headbands. We suggest using a headband that is 5 - 8 pegs wide.



MADE WITH LOVE!

Attach the embroidered tag to your favorite project. Use your darning needle, and some yarn to secure. Knot the ends and trim any extra yarn.

Hand wash your projects with mild soap and cool water. Rinse and lay flat to dry. Your tools can be used again and again.

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
