STORY

In the ninth century, the village of Vosne was a part of the St Vivant Priory. In 1866, it added 'Romanée' to its name. Vosne-Romanée, which is situated between Vougeot and Nuits-Saint-Georges, is one of the famous Côte de Nuits names.

VINEYARD NOTES

- Varietals:** Pinot Noir
Exposure & Elevation: East, South-East
Soil: Chalky marls
Viticulture: Currently undergoing Organic Conversion

WINE NOTES

- Winemaking:** The harvest was hand picked for Domaine Faiveley, and the Oenologist tastes each cuvée and only chooses the best wines from trusted producers.
Barrel-Aged: 14-16 months in French oak barrels- one third new oak
Fining & Filtration: No fining and, light filtration using the lenticular module process
Alcohol: 13%

TASTING NOTES

A ruby-red color of beautiful intensity. The nose unveils light woody and fruity aromas. The attack is supple and fruity. Then, the wine reveals its fine and pleasant tannins, which give it remarkable balance and nice volume.

This Vosne-Romanée is elegant and has good length on the palate.
