Security Kit Components

Keypad

Control Panel that arms and disarms your Ring Alarm from inside your home

Features: Emergency buttons (get Police, Fire and Medical response with the tap of a finger), Siren
Power: Plug-in with 24 hr battery backup

Contact Sensor

Secures windows and doors and sends alerts when they open

Features: Smaller design, use to trigger Alexa routines
Power: Two CR2032 coin cell batteries

Motion Detector

Detects motion inside your home

Features: Customizable, pet-friendly motion settings, smaller design, use to trigger Alexa routines
Power: Two AA batteries

Range Extender

Extends the signal from your base station to other Alarm components

Features: 250 ft radius
Power: Plug-in with 24 hr battery backup

Base Station

The brains behind it all. Keep your Ring Alarm online and connected to your devices

Features: Z-Wave Plus & Zigbee Hub, Siren
Connectivity: 2.4 GHz Wi-Fi or Ethernet
Power: Plug-in with rechargeable built-in 24 hr battery backup



Additional Ring Alarm Solutions



Flood and Freeze Sensor

Detects water and low temperatures inside your home and sends alerts



Smoke and CO Listener

Sends alerts when your existing smoke and CO alarm sounds



Panic Button

Press and hold to sound the siren in case of emergency



Echo Dot

Arm and Disarm your system with your voice and listen for glass breaks on Echo devices with Alexa Guard

Frequently Asked Questions

Will second-generation Ring Alarm devices work with my existing Ring Alarm?

Yes, you can mix and match first and second generation Ring Alarm Contact Sensors, Motion Detectors, Range Extenders, Keypads and third-party devices with any Ring Alarm Base Station.

Does Ring make a glass break sensor?

Ring Alarm pairs with Alexa-enabled devices and can listen for glass breaking with Alexa Guard. Alexa can also listen to existing Smoke/CO detectors for Smoke/CO alarms. If you have professional monitoring with a Ring Protect plan, you can also request emergency response.

Do I need to get a permit?

If you have signed up for 24/7 professional monitoring, you may need a permit to dispatch emergency services. After signing up for a specific Ring Protect plan and enroll into Professional Monitoring, you'll get an email from our dedicated Permit Team so you can have everything you need to apply for your permit. In some cases, our team will handle the entire permitting process, but for others, we'll walk you through every step to help you get your permit as quickly as possible.

How do I sign up for 24/7 professional monitoring?

You can sign up for 24/7 professional monitoring by purchasing a specific Ring Protect Plan. Once activated, it also gives you cellular backup, video recording and sharing for unlimited Ring Doorbells and Cameras at your home, extended warranties and exclusive discounts.

Currently, Ring Alarm and the professional monitoring service are available only within the U.S. (excluding American Samoa, Guam, Northern Mariana Islands, Puerto Rico, and the U.S. Virgin Islands) and Canada (excluding Quebec).
