
Please retain these instructions for future reference.

- Do not allow children to operate this appliance. Keep appliance out of reach of children.
- · Place appliance on a stable and level surface.
- · Appliance is intended for indoor, household use only.
- · Switch off and unplug appliance if left unattended and before cleaning.
- Ensure that your voltage is consistent with specifications. Only connect to properly grounded outlets.
- Do not use an extension cord as it may overheat and cause a risk of fire.
- This appliance is not intended for use by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety.
- If any parts are missing, broken, damaged, or worn, stop using this product until repairs are made and/or factory replacement parts are installed.

#### **AWARNING**

- · Do not leave oven unattended during operation in case of fire.
- · Keep appliance away from direct sunlight and other sources of heat (stove, heater, oven, etc.).
- Do not run power cord over sharp edges/corners or a hot surface.
- Make sure power cord is not taut, bent, or tangled, and is arranged so it cannot be tripped over unintentionally.
- · Do not pull or carry appliance by the power cord.
- Never cover the appliance during operation.
- · Do not obstruct vents and openings during operation.
- Do not place items on top of the appliance during operation.
- Do not use the appliance if there is damage to the plug, main cord, or appliance.
- Do not immerse this appliance in water, rinse under tap, spray with water, or keep in wet/humid areas.



#### **CRUMB TRAY**




#### PAN HANDLE:

Use to pull out the rotisserie shaft/forks




#### **ROTISSERIE SHAFT/FORKS:**

Use with the rotisserie presets




#### **CONTROL PANEL**



- START/OFF: Press to start cooking or turn off
- CONVENTION: Toggle convection function on/off
  Convection function is only available in certain presets
- FUNCTION DIAL: Rotate to turn oven on and cycle through cooking, oven, and toast presets
- TIMER DIAL: Adjust cook time; further adjust toast preset from light (1) to dark (7)

#### **DIGITAL DISPLAY**



- OVEN PRESETS: Indicates oven heating and rotisserie presets
- TOAST PRESETS: Indicates light (1) to dark (7) toast presets
  - Temp. and time cannot be adjusted in toast presets

#### **PREPARATION**

- · Remove all packaging materials.
- Place appliance on a stable and level surface and plug it into a wall outlet.
- · Clean accessories with hot water, mild detergent, and a non-abrasive sponge.
- · Wipe interior and exterior of oven with a clean cloth.
- Leave at least 4 inches of clearance around the appliance during operation.
- · Make sure power cord has enough length to reach the socket comfortably.
- · Place appliance away from edges or drops.
- Do not use appliance outdoors or near water.
- Do not use appliance in a hot environment or in the vicinity of flammable materials (e.g. curtains, drapes, walls, etc.)

#### **USAGE TIPS**


- Be aware that appliance will still operate if doors are open.
- Do not open appliance during operation. Cancel cooking operation before opening doors.
- Do not touch glass doors during operation as it will be extremely hot.
- Do not place utensils or lean anything against the glass doors during operation.
- Do not place hands or face close to the glass doors during operation.
- · Avoid scratching or nicking glass door.
- · Always use protective, insulated oven mitts when inserting or removing items from the oven.
- · Be careful when handling pans, trays, racks, or grease from oven as they are extremely hot.
- · Be careful when opening oven as steam may be released.
- Use extreme caution when emptying trays and allow liquids to fully cool before handling.
- · Only use containers made of metal, glass, or ceramic in the oven.
- · Do not place paper, cardboard, or plastic inside the oven.
- Dehydrate function: It is recommended that you open the doors every 30 minutes to release humidity.

#### **OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS**

- 1. Slide the crumb tray into the bottom floor of the oven.
- 2. Place ingredients onto desired racks/pan and slide into the designated slots.
- 3. Rotate the function dial to turn oven on and select a preset.
  - If necessary, adjust the cook time/temperature with the timer and temperature dials.
- 4. Press the START button to begin cooking.
- 5. The oven will beep when cooking is finished. Press the OFF button to turn off. Carefully remove racks/pan with the pan handle or oven mitts.

#### **ROTISSERIE FUNCTION**

- 1. Slide the crumb tray into the bottom floor of the oven.
- 2. Properly clean protein and pat dry with paper towels. Slide the rotisserie shaft through the center of the protein. Make sure the shaft is centered and even on both sides.
- **3.** Slide the rotisserie forks onto the shaft, one on each side. Tighten the screws to secure the forks and hold the protein in place.
- 4. Cut several lengths of kitchen twine and tie the protein. Make sure all openings are closed and protein is secure.
- 5. Within the oven, insert the right side of the rotisserie shaft into the designated hole. Hook the left side onto the slot.



- 6. Close the doors. Select one of the rotisserie presets and press the START button to begin cooking.
- 7. The oven will beep when cooking is finished. Press the OFF button to turn off. Carefully remove the rotisserie shaft with the rotisserie handle. Tug the handle left to release the accessory and pull it out.
