STORY

This parcel is situated in the northern part of the village just before the valley. This climat's name is derived from “La Val”, the term used in the Middle Ages to refer to a low point in the land, a topographic rift. Along with “Les Cazetiers” and “Clos Saint-Jacques”, this climat is considered to be one of the 3 best Premiers Crus in Gevrey. The Domaine purchased this parcel in late 2013.

WINE NOTES

Fermentation:	Partial whole cluster fermentation with daily punch downs for a 19 day vatting period
Barrel-Aged:	16 months in French oak barrels- 40-50% new oak
Fining & Filtration:	No fining and, light filtration using the lenticular module process
Alcohol:	13.5%

TASTING NOTES

Deep ruby red color with an attractive nose offering intense aromas of small black fruits. A powerful, warm and concentrated wine with exceptional aromatic intensity with elegant tannins and a touch of leather that lingers on the finish.
