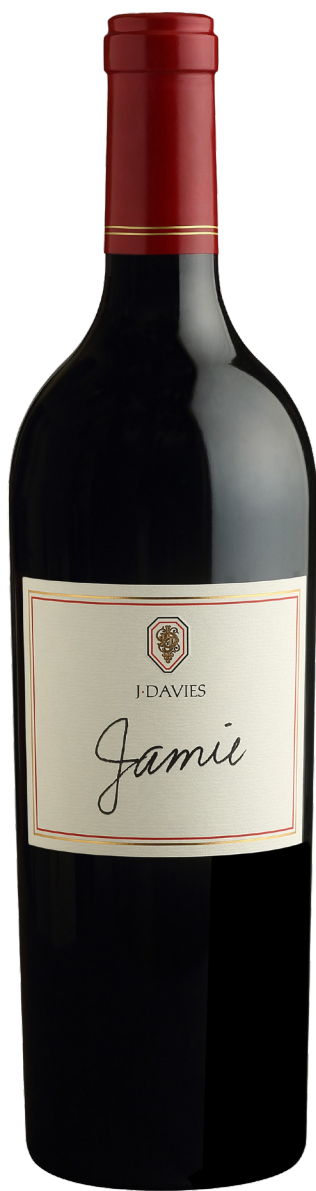

2022 JAMIE, ESTATE CABERNET SAUVIGNON DIAMOND MOUNTAIN DISTRICT, NAPA VALLEY

WINERY

After Jack and Jamie Davies revived the historic Schramsberg property in Napa Valley, their son, Hugh Davies, initiated a red wine program using the family's estate vineyards on Diamond Mountain. Starting in the 1990s, Hugh undertook the replanting of the home property to red Bordeaux varietals leading to the J. Davies Cabernet program; he later partnered with North Coast growers to launch Davies Vineyards Pinot Noirs.

WINE

The Davies family, proprietors of Schramsberg and Davies Vineyards in Napa Valley, presents the tenth vintage of J. Davies Estate "Jamie," the finest Cabernet Sauvignon from its historic Diamond Mountain property. Named in honor of Schramsberg matriarch Jamie Davies, the wine reflects the legacy she and her husband Jack began in 1965 with their vision of producing world-class American sparkling wine. Today, a second generation of the Davies family, led by son Hugh and his wife Monique, continues that legacy through the production of exceptional Cabernet Sauvignon from the family's hillside estate.

VINEYARDS

The vineyard blocks, totaling 46 acres, are laid out in four isolated pockets ranging from 500 to 1000 feet in elevation. They include the two Schram sections, Napa Valley's first hillside vineyards, originally planted in 1862 by Jacob Schram, the McEachran parcel, first planted by Colin McEachran in 1878, and

the Claes parcel, dating back to 1984. These are the southernmost vineyards in the Diamond Mountain District AVA. Flanked by two cool creek canyons (Nash Creek to the north and Ritchie Creek to the south) and surrounded by compact coniferous and deciduous forests, the vines here produce late-ripening, richly concentrated fruit with average yields of just two tons per acre.

VINTAGE NOTES

The 2022 vintage began with heavy winter rainfall, followed by a dry spring and warm summer. A record September heatwave accelerated harvest. The varied conditions produced Napa Valley Cabernet with profiles ranging from vibrant and elegant to rich and powerful.

WINEMAKING

26 months in 67% new French oak.

TASTING NOTES

"Our 2022 J. Davies Estate "Jamie" Cabernet Sauvignon opens with black cherry, cassis, and citrus peel, layered with forest floor, eucalyptus, espresso, and roasted almond. The palate shows black raspberry, blueberry, sarsaparilla, and cocoa, framed by fine-grained tannins and a rich, lingering finish."
