
ASSEMBLY AND INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

WARNING: TO AVOID RISK OF ELECTRICAL SHOCK, BE SURE TO SHUT OFF POWER WHILE INSTALLING OR SERVICING THIS FIXTURE.

NOTE: 1. Before installing, consult local electrical codes for wiring and grounding requirements.

2. Read and save this instructions.




- 1. Unscrew the two set screws (D), remove the fixture from the mounting plate unit (A).
- 2. Attach the mounting plate unit (A) to the outlet box by using two mounting screws (B).
- 3. Pull out the source wires from the outlet box. Make wire connections using wire connectors (C) as follows:
 - ---Connect the hot wire (black insulation) from the fixture to the black wire from the power source.
 - --- Connect the neutral wire (white insulation) from the fixture to the white wire from the power source.
 - ---Attach the fixture ground wire (bare wire) to the mounting plate unit (A) with the green ground screw, then connect it to the house ground wire with the wire connector (C).

Carefully put the wires back into the outlet box.

- 4. Attach the canopy to the mounting plate unit (A) by using the set screws (D).
- 5. Attach the bracket to the fixture by using the metal plate with two set screws-a.
- 6. Install 4 x 60W Max. candelabra base bulbs (not included). See relamping label at socket area or packaging for maximum wattage allowed.
- 7. Hang the glasses on the fixture as the picture shown.

Turn on the power at fuse or circuit box





Outlet Box
