





ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS BY WALL TYPE:

- DRYWALL WITH STUDS: Use screws to affix to studs, and use hollow wall anchors and screws to affix to drywall. See FIGURE A.
- DRYWALL WITHOUT STUDS: Use toggle bolt and screws to affix to drywall. See FIGURE B.







DRYWALL W/STUDS


Place the back of Etagere (Sold separately) on a soft flat surface. Remove the side frame (A1/A2) of the etagere by loosening all Allen bolts




- Place the back of side frame (A1/B1) on a soft flat surface.
- 3. Attach the minifix bolts (5) into the fixed nuts on the side frame (A1/B1) as per illustrated in FIGURE 02-A.
- Remove the mini fix lock from the mini fix nut (6), as per illustrated in FIGURE 02-B. Insert the minifix nuts into the holes on bottom of 4. stretcher (A5), then use a screwdriver to adjust the minifix nut to make sure the hole on it is aligned with the bore hole on the end of the stretcher, as per illustrated in FIGURE 03-C.
- Align the minifix bolt (5) on the side frame into the minifix nut (6) through the bore hole on the end of the stretcher (B4). Re-insert the minifix lock to secure the minifix bolt to the minifix nut, and the stretcher will be fixed to the side frame. See FIGURE 02-D.




- 6. Attach the Shelf frame 1 (A3) into the side frame, align and insert Allen bolt (1) together with lock washer (2) and flat washer (3) to each fixed nuts under top through the hole on the side frame. Tighten all the bolts by using wrench (4). **DO NOT FULLY TIGHTEN**. See **FIGURE 03**.
- 7. Repeat for the another Shelf frame 1.
- 8. Before assembly the Shelf frame 2 (A4), remove the support rails on the right side of the Shelf frame 2 by lossening all allen bolts installed on the support wood (A6) as in **FIGURE 04-A**, then move the support wood (A6) to next location and tighten all bolts as in **FIGURE 04-B**.
- 9. Attach the Shelf frame 2 (A4) into the side frame, align and insert Allen bolt (1) together with lock washer (2) and flat washer (3) to each fixed nuts under top through the hole on the side frame. Tighten all the bolts by using wrench (4). **DO NOT FULLY TIGHTEN**. See **FIGURE 05-A & 05-B**.
- 10. Repeat for the other Shelf frame 2. After assembly, re-tighten all bolts for a snug fit. **DO NOT OVER TIGHTEN**.





Attach the Shelf frame 1 (B2) of the Block B into the side frame (B1) of the Block B and Right Side frame (A2) of the Block A, align and insert

- 16. Before assembly the Shelf frame 2 (B3), please checking and watching careflly the note **A**. Then attach the Support wood (B5) into the center insert nut as in **FIGURE 08**.
- 17. Attach the Shelf frame 2 (B3) into the side frame (B1) and Right Side frame (A2), align and insert Allen bolt (1) together with lock washer (2) and flat washer (3) to each fixed nuts under top through the hole on the side frame. Tighten all the bolts by using wrench (4). **DO NOT FULLY TIGHTEN**. See **FIGURE 09-A & 09-B**.
- 18. Repeat for the other Shelf frame 2. After assembly, re-tighten all bolts for a snug fit. **DO NOT OVER TIGHTEN**.



FURNITURE TIPPING RESTRAINT INSTRUCTIONS

ANTI-TIP-KIT INSTALLATION INSTRUCTION

⚠WARNING: Always mount metal brackets to solid wood of furniture. Do not attach to plywood of back panels.

WE RECOMMEND ATTACHING TO STUDS.

- Attach mounting brackets (7) near the middle-top back edge of the furniture piece by inserting the shorter screws (11).
- Determine the final position of the furniture piece. Mark locations on the wall approximately 2" below the brackets mounted to the back of the furniture.
- 3. Attach the second brackets to stud wall by inserting the longer screw (12) (See Figure A) or toggle bolt (13) with drywall (See Figure B).
- 4. Place the furniture so that the brackets on the back edge are in line with the brackets in the wall.
- 5. Insert the clevis pin (8) through holes on brackets and hole on steel aircraft cable (9). Use hair pin (10) to go through small hole on clevis pin (8) to lock it.
- 6. Repeat above step to attach the end of aircraft cable (9) to the bracket on the wall.
- 7. Check to make sure the steel aircraft cable is securely laced and locked to the brackets.

CARE INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Dust often using a clean, soft, dry and lint-free cloth.
- 2. Blot spills immediately and wipe with a clean, damp cloth.
- 3. We do not recommend the use of chemical cleansers, abrasives or furniture polish on our lacquered finish.
