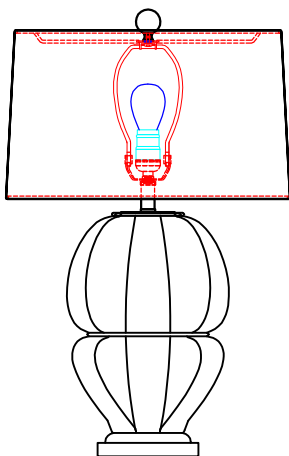
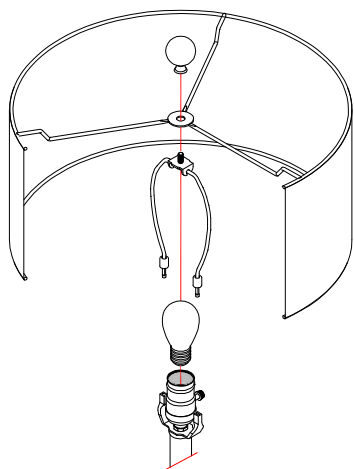

WARNINGS

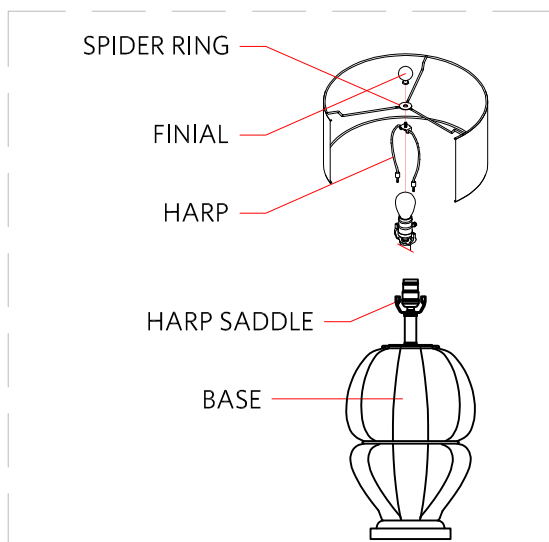
- All wires are connected; do not remove the lamp from its packaging by pulling on the power cord, as a bad connection may result.
- Do not connect electricity until the lamp is fully assembled.
- To reduce the risk of fire, electrical shock, or personal injury, always turn off and unplug lamp and allow it to cool prior to replacing light bulb.
- Do not touch bulb when fixture is turned on or look directly at lit bulb.
- Keep flammable materials away from lit bulb.
- Suitable for indoor use only.
- If the external flexible cable or cord of this luminaire is damage, it shall be exclusively replace by the manufacturer or his service agent or a similar qualified person in order to avoid a hazard.

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Place the base on a flat working surface.
2. Squeeze the harp inward and set into the opening of the harp saddle. And once the harp is set then remove the finial from harp.
3. Align and insert the shade spider ring into the threaded nipple of the harp and secure these with the finial.
4. Install Type A 70-W maximum bulb into the socket.

CARE INSTRUCTIONS:

Avoid the use of all polishers, cleaners, and abrasives, as they will damage the finish of your lamp. To remove dust or fingerprints, wipe gently with a soft, clean cloth.
