



# 2024 MOSCATO D'ASTI DOCG

#### **WINERY**

The Cogno family has been making wine in the Langhe area of Piedmont for four generations. The values of history and traditions handed down by father Elvio are enhanced by the freshness and innovation introduced by his daughter Nadia and her husband Valter Fissore.

### **WINE**

Moscato d'Asti is a charming and aromatic wine known for its sweet profile and vibrant character. The Moscato d'Asti by Cogno offers a clear and faithful interpretation of the grape, highlighting its typical aromatic profile. It shows a delicate balance of sweetness and freshness, with an intense aromatic bouquet that reflects the purity of the fruit.

#### **VINEYARDS**

The grapes, traditionally harvested, come from a 1-hectare vineyard. The vines, whose density is 4000 plants per hectare, are trained with Guyot system.

#### VINTAGE NOTES

The 2024 season began with mild, dry weather, but by late February, heavy and sustained rainfall set in. While challenging, this rain helped prevent summer water stress, though it required extra vineyard care. Vine growth

remained on schedule and progressed well. By mid-July, warm, sunny days returned, accelerating ripening and leading to timely veraison. Harvest followed a traditional timeline, with all Nebbiolo picked before October 15th, just ahead of poor weather. Careful vineyard management ensured excellent grape health and optimal ripeness across all varieties.

#### WINEMAKING

Soft pressing, clarification, fermentation with control of temperature at 59°F, with selected yeasts in slight pressing without malolactic fermentation.

# **TASTING NOTES**

Brilliant straw-yellow in color, the Moscato d'Asti 2024 opens with a vibrant and expressive bouquet of Mediterranean herbs like sage and rosemary, delicately woven with white blossoms and bright citrus. The palate is juicy and generous, offering a satisfying sweetness and a long, lingering finish filled with ripe fruit.
