

# GAJA

## 2022 DAGROMIS BAROLO DOP



### WINERY

Located in Piedmont in northwestern Italy, the GAJA winery is widely considered to be one of the greatest estates in the world, producing coveted and collectible labels.

### WINE

Expression of two great terroirs of Barolo, La Morra and Serralunga. “Gromis” was the previous owner of the land.

### VINEYARDS

Barolo Dagromis is a blend of vineyards with different exposures, soils, and ages. All these factors give different characteristics and complexity to the wine. The vineyards are located in La Morra and in Serralunga d’Alba.

### VINTAGE NOTES

The vintage was challenging but ultimately produced high quality grapes with small berries and thick skins, resulting in aromatic, structured wines with richness and long finishes. Winter was cold and rainy with heavy snowfall, followed by a dry spring. Early warmth accelerated vine growth, but frost on April 7–8 damaged some Nebbiolo in lower Barbaresco vineyards, while higher-altitude Barolo vineyards were unaffected. Summer was variable, windy early, hot with thunderstorms mid-season, and hot and dry toward the end. Barbaresco experienced higher humidity and powdery mildew pressure, while Barolo remained drier. Late August rains refreshed the vines, and

after additional September rain and cooler temperatures, Nebbiolo ripened slowly. Harvest began September 21 in Barbaresco and concluded October 14 in Serralunga d’Alba (Barolo).

### WINEMAKING

The grapes from each vineyard are vinified separately, with each lot undergoing fermentation and maceration prior to aging.

### TASTING NOTES

The nose shows deep wet earth, warm spice, sandalwood, juniper, red fruit, and subtle savory, sanguine notes. Powerful and concentrated on the palate, it is balanced by bright savory acidity and dense yet polished tannins, finishing fresh with a hint of blood orange.
