CARE AND CLEANING INSTRUCTION GUIDE

INTRODUCTION

This Natural Collection speaker is built to hold its finish for years. A little routine care keeps the grille and finish looking and the speaker sounding their best.

TWO RULES FOR EVERY CLEAN

1. Use only natural-based cleaning products that are alcohol-free.
2. Always wipe lengthwise along the speaker from end to end, never across or in circles.

BEFORE YOU BEGIN

- Turn the speaker off or mute the source so debris isn't drawn into a driver.
- Apply cleaner to the cloth first. Never spray anything directly onto the speaker.
- Use a soft, lint-free microfiber cloth. Let the cloth do the work; don't scrub.

HOW TO CLEAN

- Wipe lengthwise, in the same direction as the speaker's length, end to end.
- Use light, even passes; no circles or cross strokes.
- Finish with a clean, dry cloth in the same lengthwise direction.
- **FABRIC GRILLE** | Dust lengthwise with a dry cloth or soft brush; for trapped dust, use low-suction vacuum with a brush attachment held just off the surface. Don't press the grille inward.
- **FINISH - SPEAKER CABINET** | Lightly apply a natural, alcohol-free cleaner to the cloth, wipe lengthwise, then dry immediately.
- **WIRE TERMINALS** | Keep dry, dust only, no liquid.

REMOVING MARKS AND FINGERPRINTS

- Dampen the cloth with a natural, alcohol-free cleaner (or plain water) so it's just barely moist.
- Wipe gently, lengthwise, then dry right away.
- For stubborn spots, repeat the lengthwise pass rather than scrubbing harder.

WHAT TO AVOID

- No alcohol, ammonia, bleach, acetone, or solvent-based cleaners.
- No abrasive pads, scouring sponges, or stiff brushes.
- No spraying product directly onto the speaker; no soaking or submerging.
- No compressed-air blasting into the speaker driver or grille.

FOR INSTALLERS AND DEALERS

- Clean before final walkthrough, always lengthwise so no dust or fingerprints remain.
- Confirm the customer has a natural, alcohol-free cleaner and knows the lengthwise technique at handoff.
- Note the finish/material on the account record so the right care guidance carries through.
